

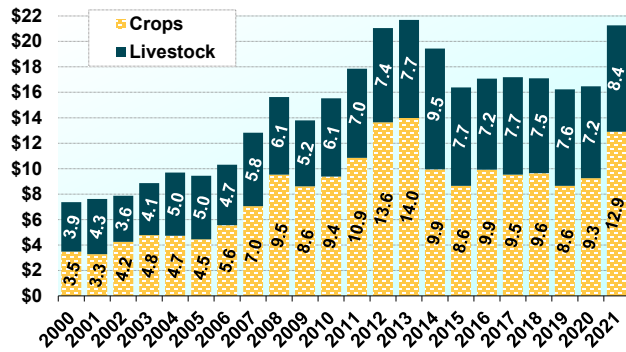
Minnesota Agricultural Rankings

(Among all U.S. states)

- #7 in total agricultural production (\$21.3 billion)
- #5 in crops (\$12.9 billion)
 - #1 in sugar beets, oats, wild rice, red kidney beans
 - #2 in sweet corn, green peas
 - #3 in soybeans, dry beans, sunflower
 - #4 in corn, canola
 - #6 in harvested acres of principal crops
 - #7 in barley
 - #9 in wheat, potatoes, snap beans
- #7 in livestock (\$8.4 billion)
 - #1 in turkeys raised
 - #2 in hogs
 - #6 in red meat, cheese, honey
 - #7 in milk, mink pelts, mohair
 - #8 in cattle on feed

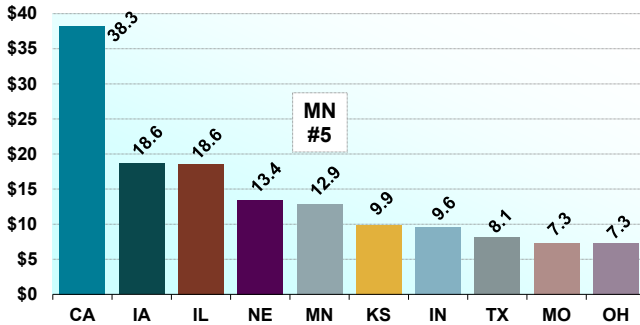
Minnesota Crop & Livestock Marketing

(Billion \$)



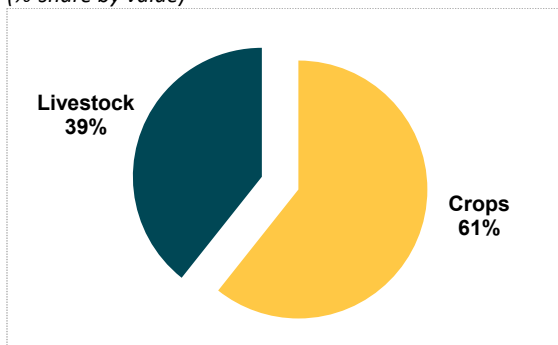
U.S. Top 10 States: Crops

(Billion \$)



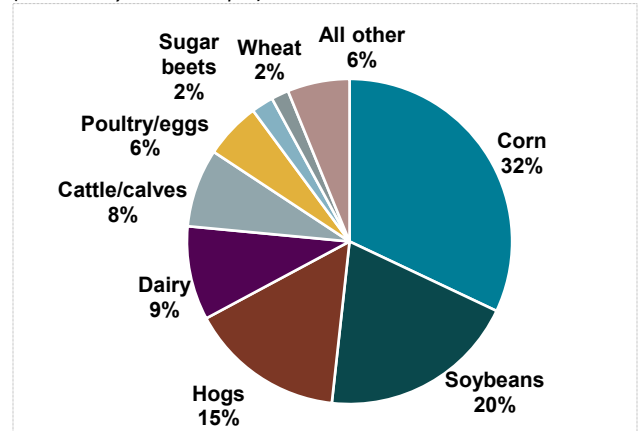
Minnesota Crop & Livestock Production

(%share by value)



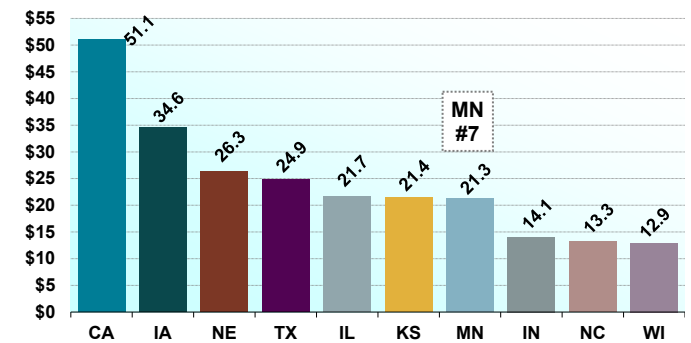
Minnesota Agricultural Marketing

(%share by cash receipts)



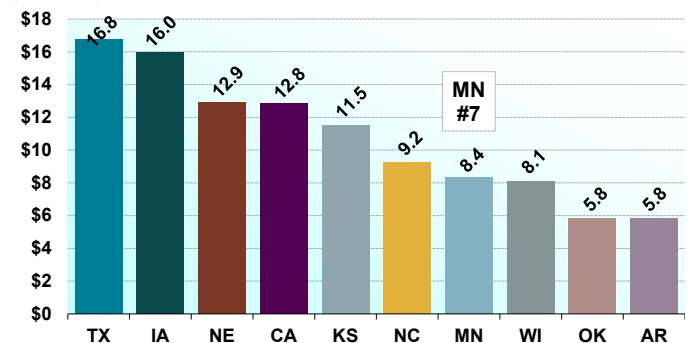
U.S. Top 10 States: Total Agriculture

(Billion \$)



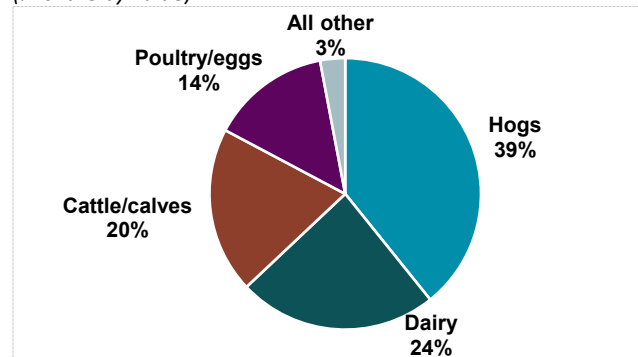
U.S. Top 10 States: Livestock

(%share by value)



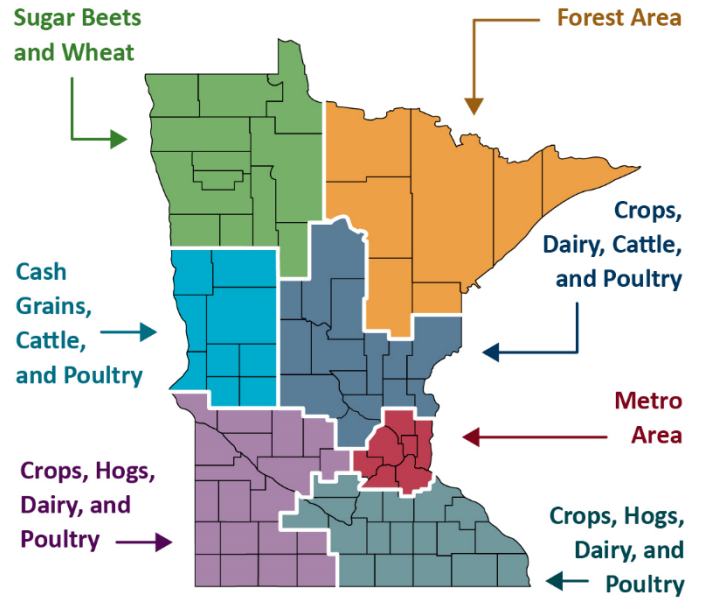
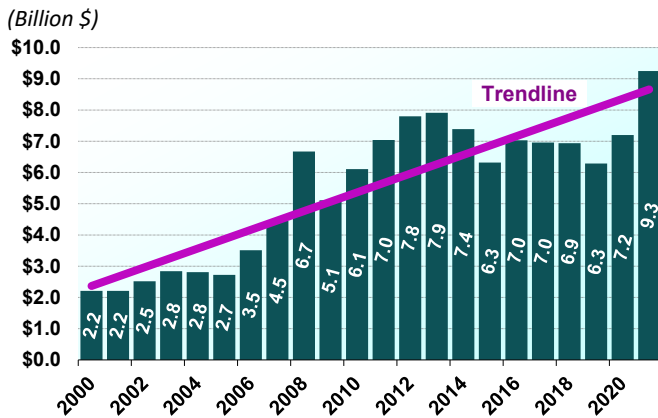
Minnesota Agriculture Facts

- Population: 5.7 million – ranks 22nd in the U.S. (rural: 23%; urban: 77%)
- Farmland: 26 million acres (51% of total land area)
- Number of farms: 67,400 (ranks #10 in U.S.)
- Average farm size: 377 acres
- Agricultural marketing: \$21.3 billion (2021)
 - Crops: \$12.9 billion
 - Livestock: \$8.4 billion
- At \$21.3 billion, Minnesota accounted for 5% of U.S. farm cash receipts in 2021

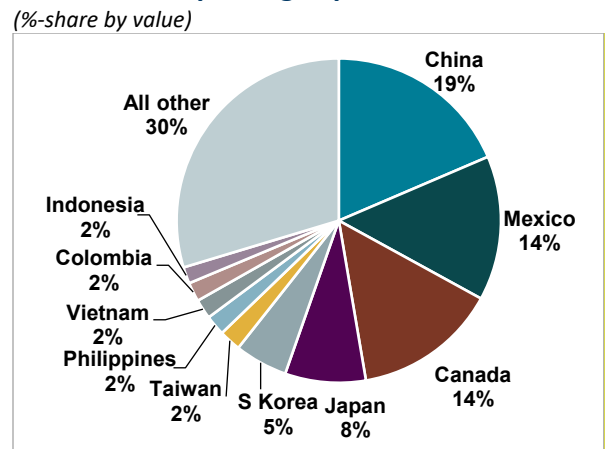
Minnesota Agricultural Exports

- 2021 agricultural exports: \$9.3 billion

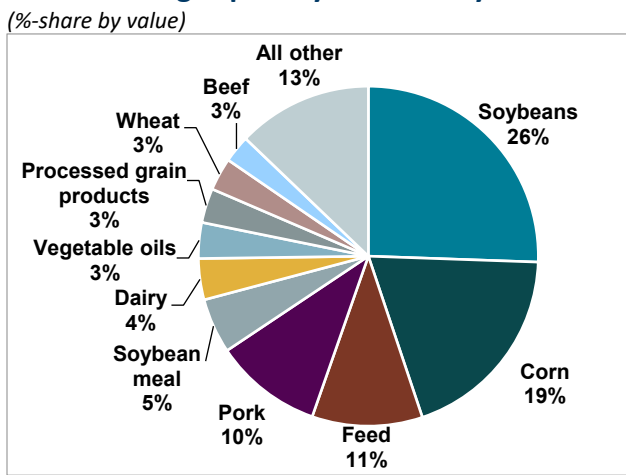
Minnesota Agricultural Export Trends



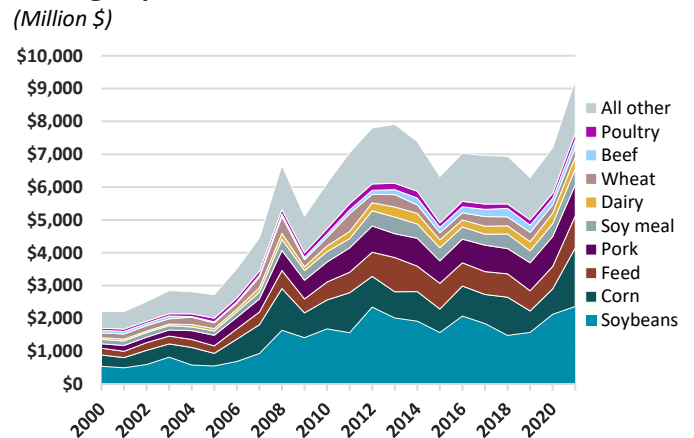
Minnesota Top 10 Ag Export Markets
