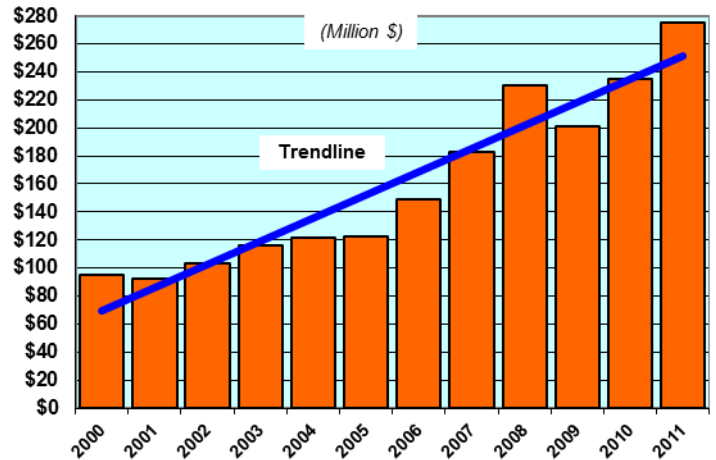

 - Non-farm employment: 8,468 jobs

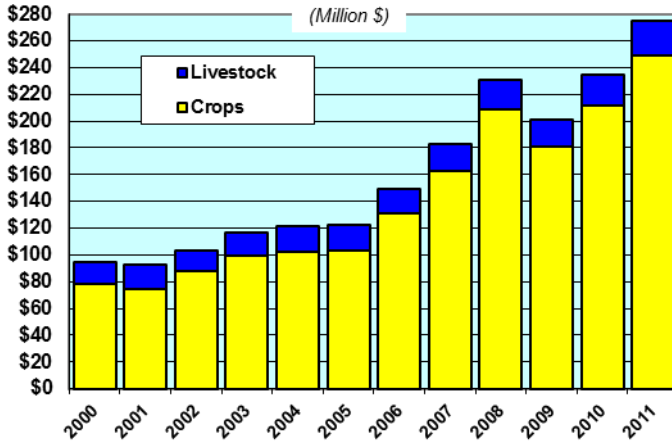
Chippewa County Agricultural Rankings: (Among all MN counties)

- No. 32 in total agricultural production

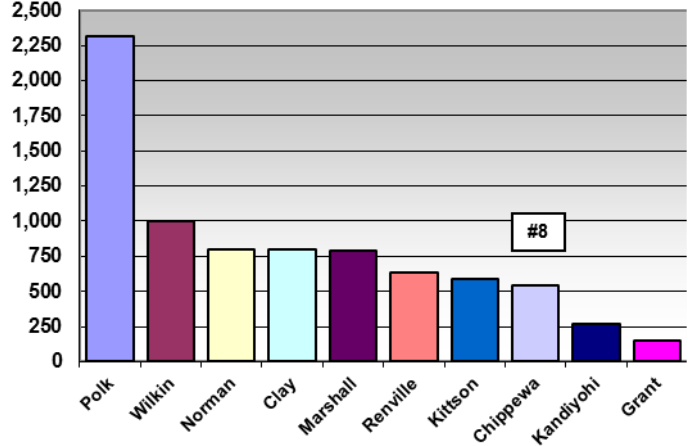

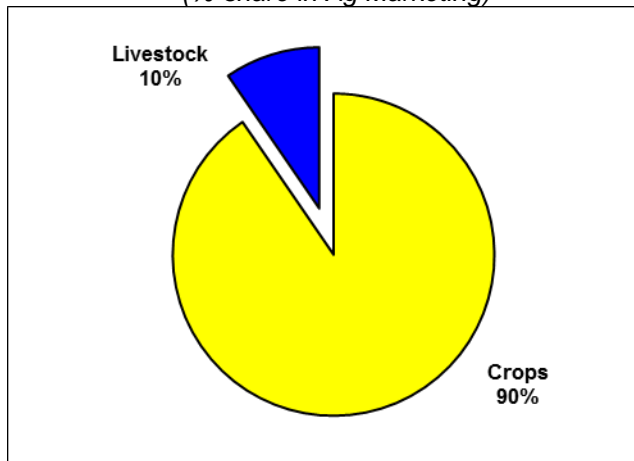
Chippewa County Crop & Livestock Marketing



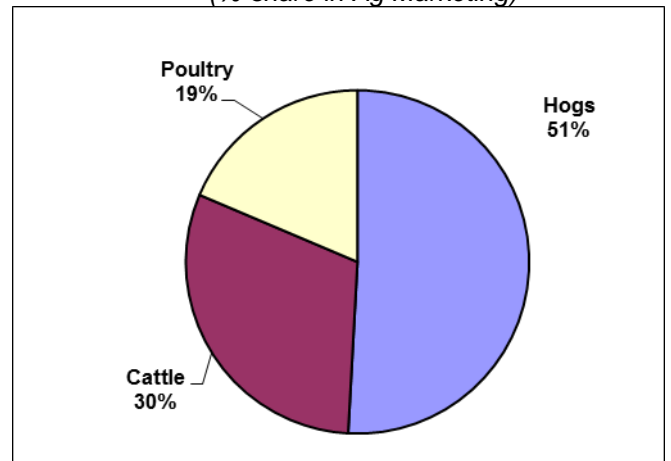
Minnesota Top Counties: Sugarbeets (Million tons)



Chippewa County Crop & Livestock (%-share in Ag Marketing)

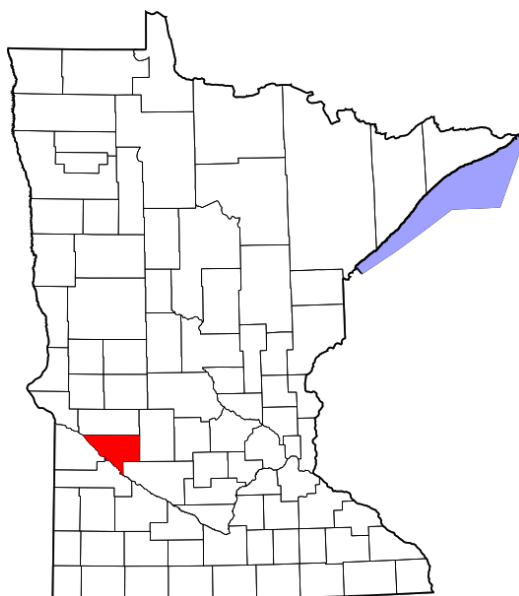


Chippewa County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
