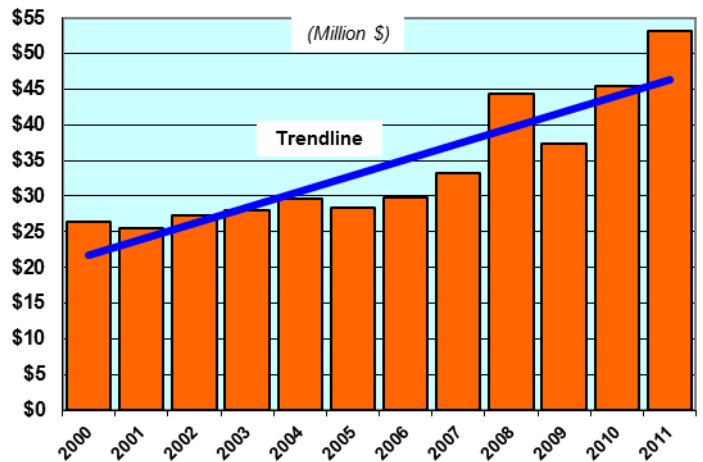

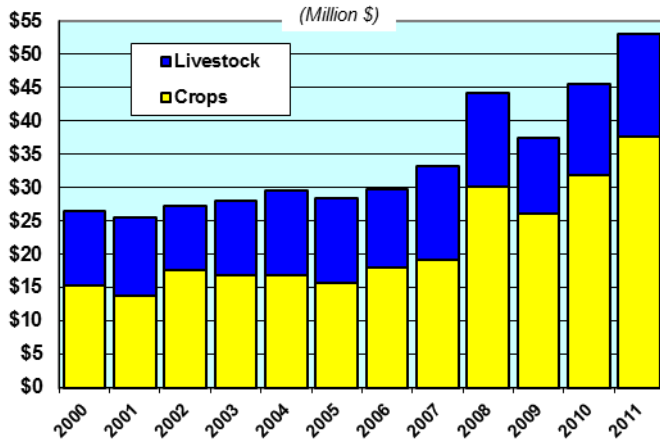

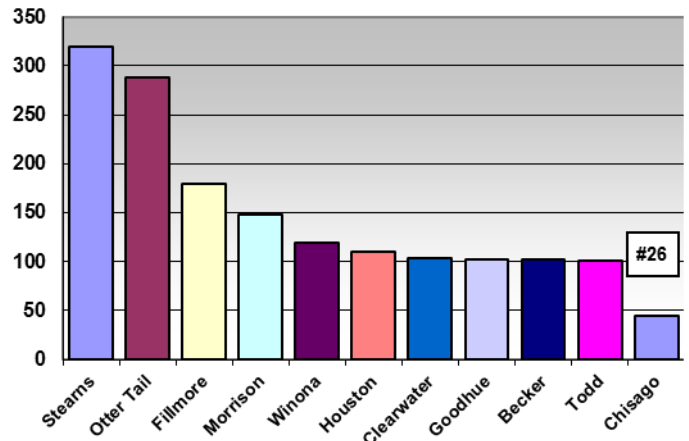

## Chisago County Crop & Livestock Marketing

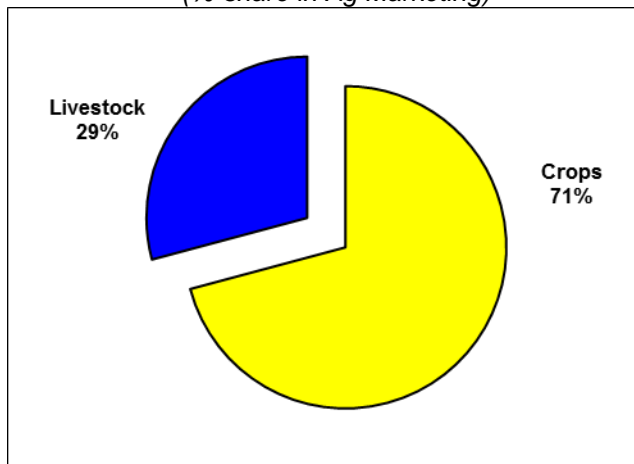


## Minnesota Top Counties: Alfalfa Hay (Million tons)



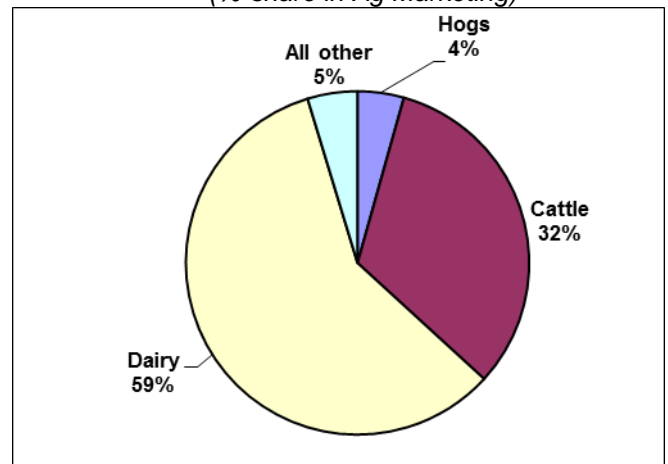
## Chisago County Crop & Livestock

(%-share in Ag Marketing)



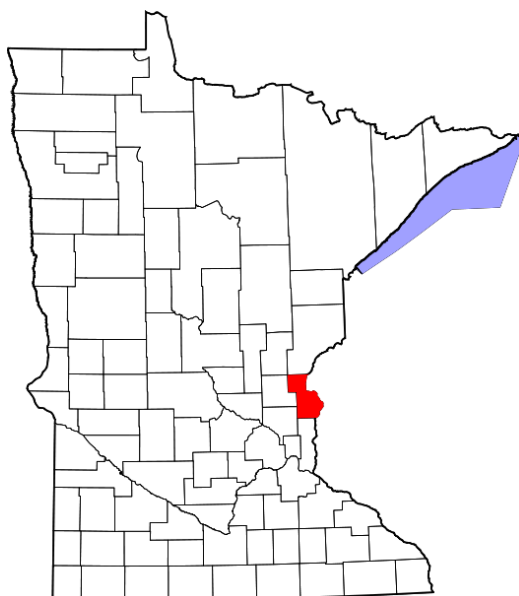
## Chisago County Livestock Sectors
