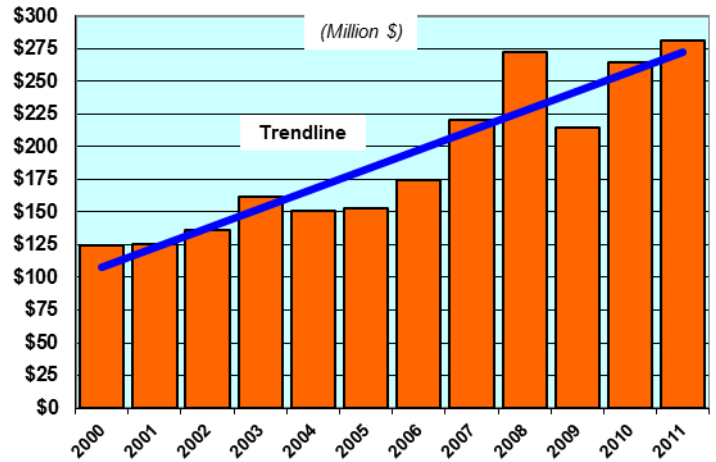

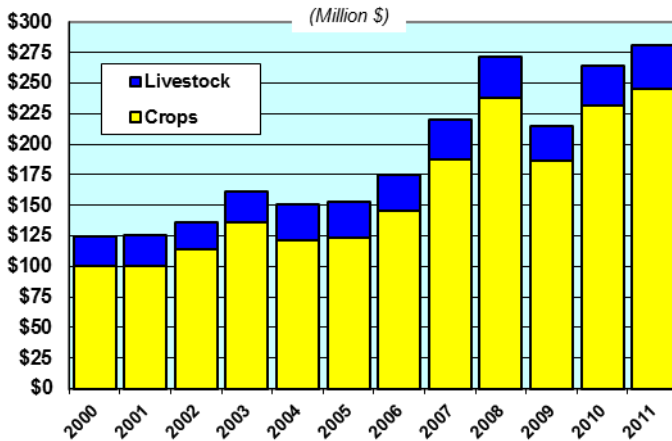

 - No. 16 in soybeans

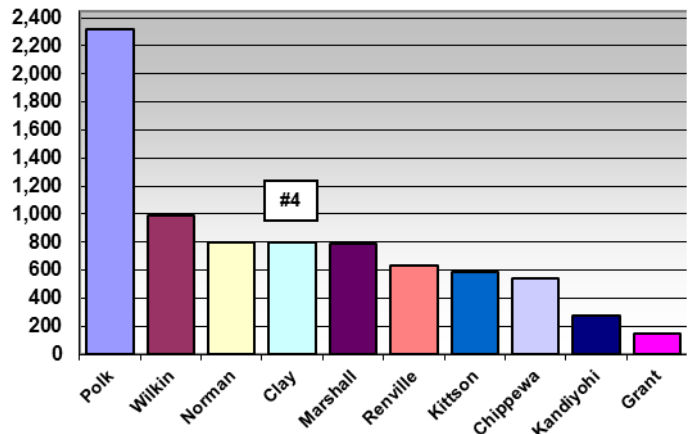

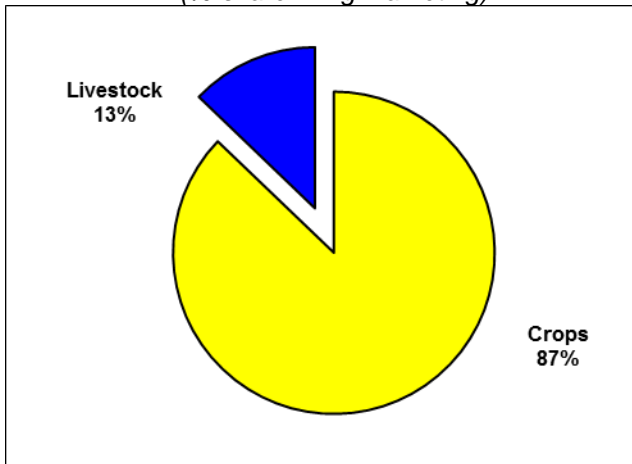
Clay County Crop & Livestock Marketing



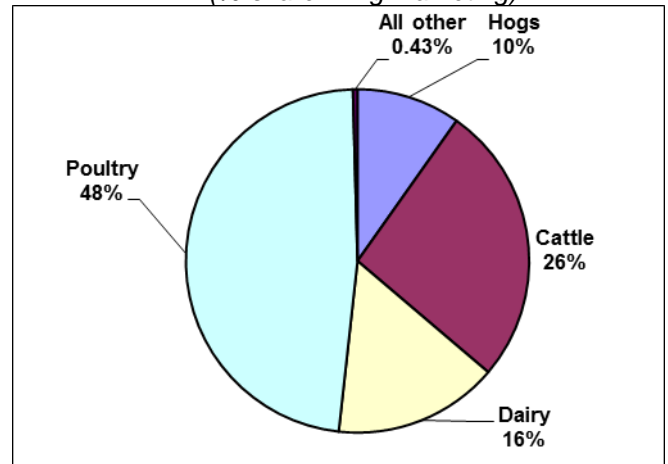
Minnesota Top Counties: Sugarbeets (Thousand tons)



Clay County Crop & Livestock (%-share in Ag Marketing)

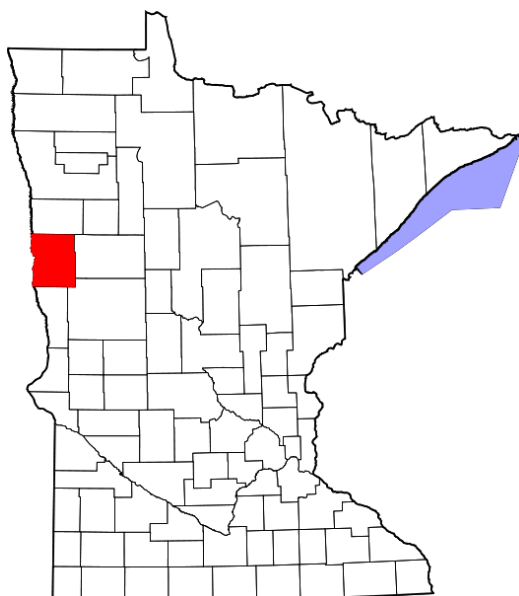


Clay County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
