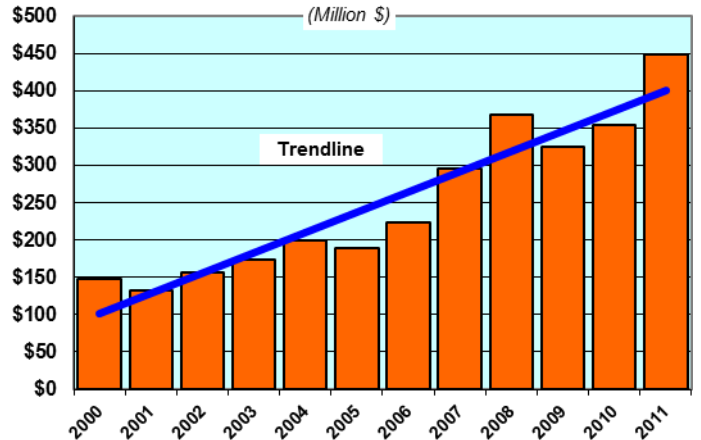

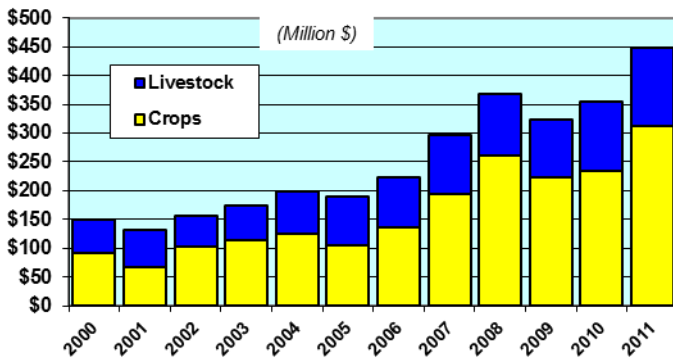

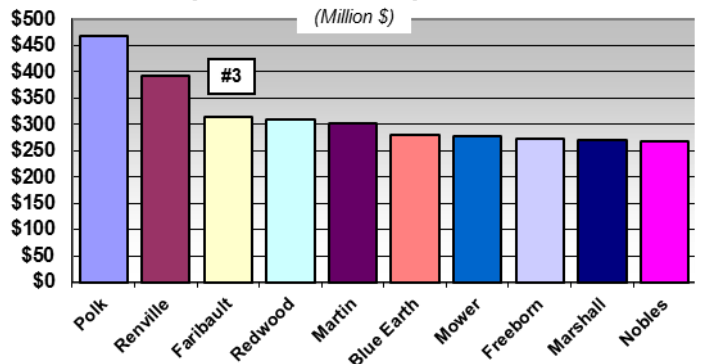

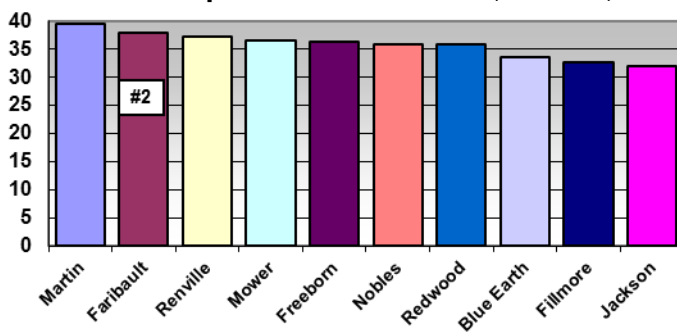
Faribault County Crop & Livestock Marketing



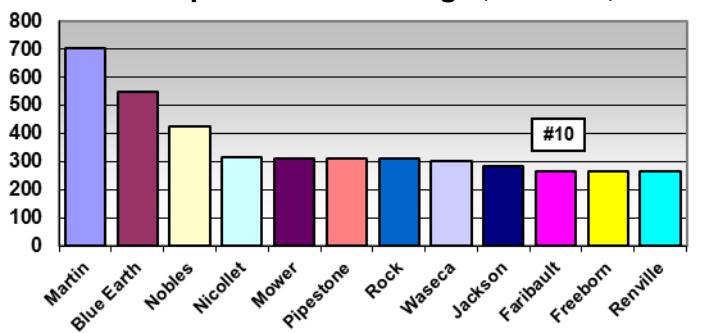
MN Top Counties: Crop Production



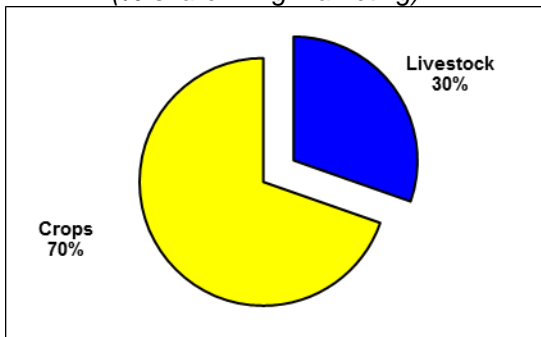
MN Top 10 Counties: Corn (Million bu.)



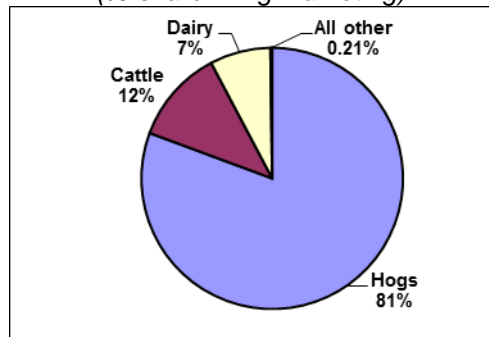
MN Top 10 Counties: Hogs (1,000 head)



Faribault County Crop & Livestock Production (%-share in Ag Marketing)

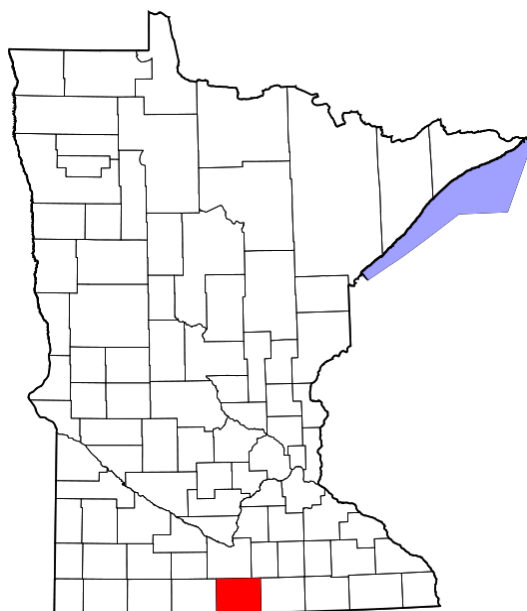


Faribault County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
