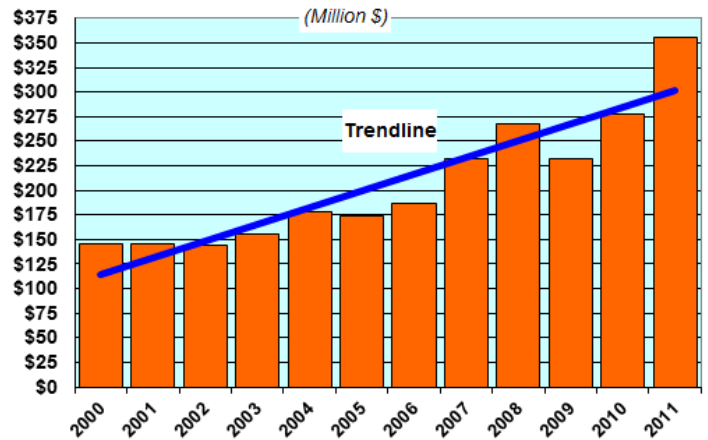

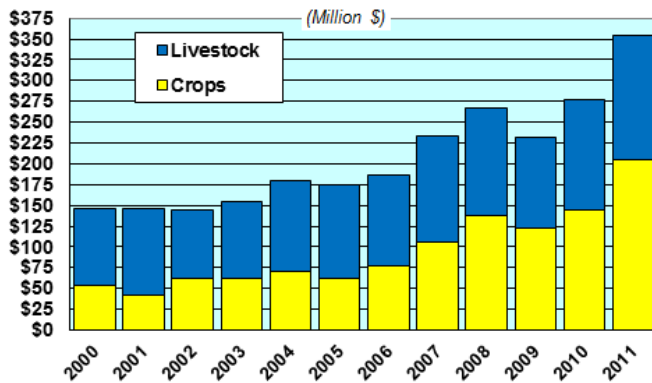

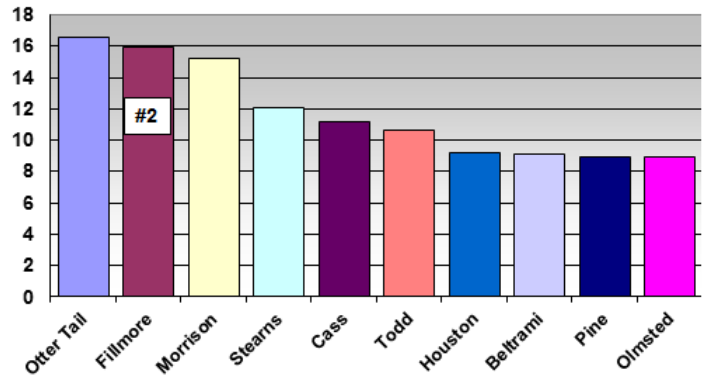

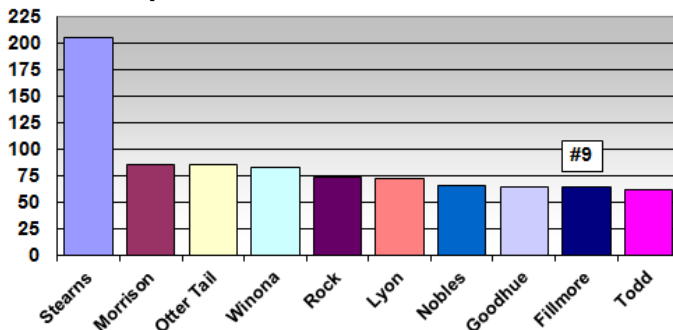

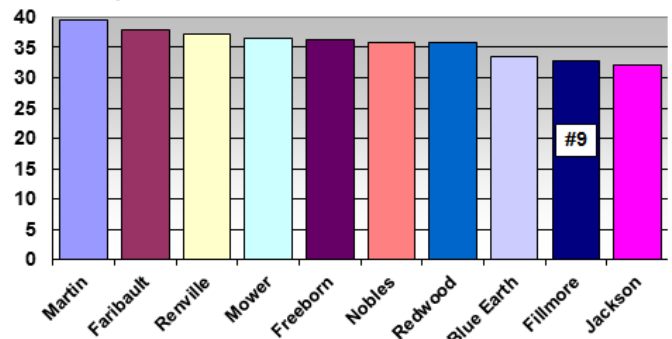
MN Top Counties: Beef Cows (1,000 head)



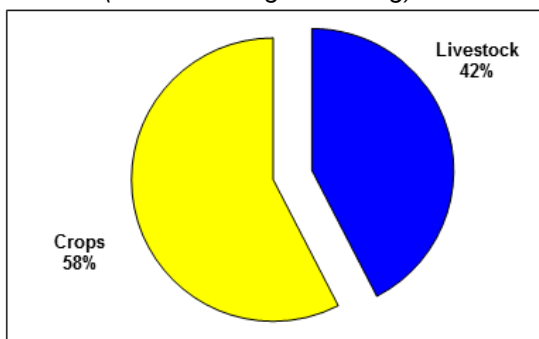
MN Top 10 Counties: All Cattle (1,000 head)



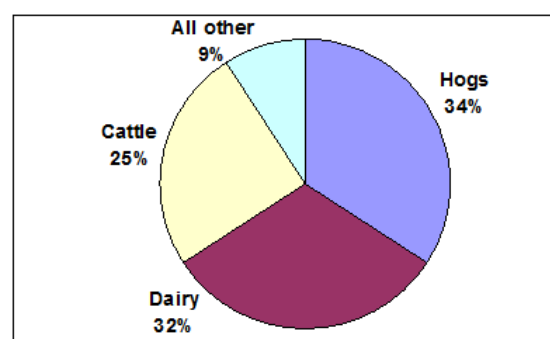
MN Top 10 Counties: Corn for Grain (Million bu.)



Fillmore County Crop & Livestock (%-share in Ag Marketing)

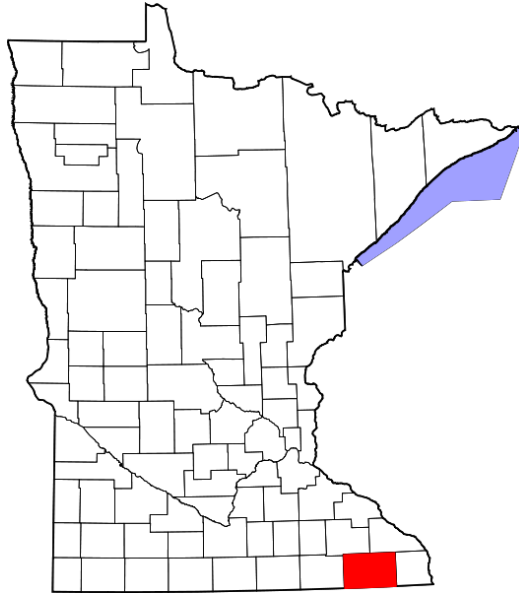


Fillmore County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
