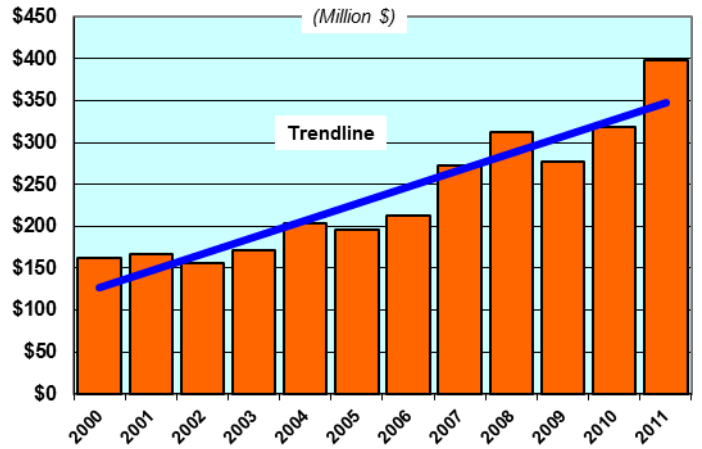

  - Non-farm employment: 27,477 jobs

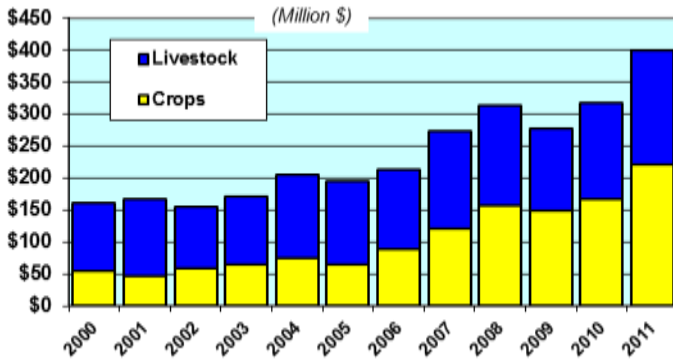
## Goodhue County Agricultural Rankings: (Among all MN counties):

- No. 14 in total agricultural production

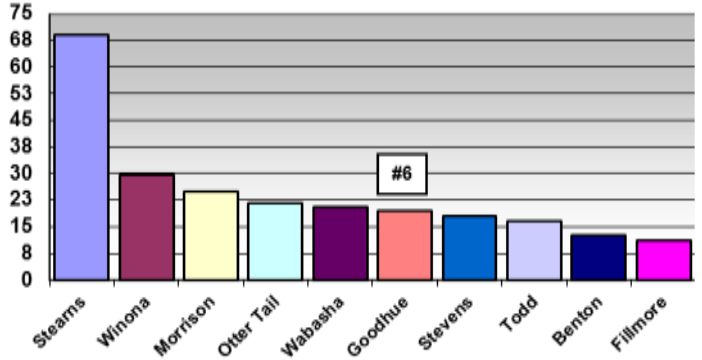

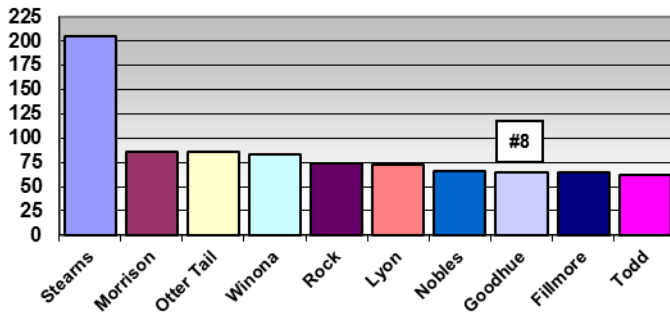

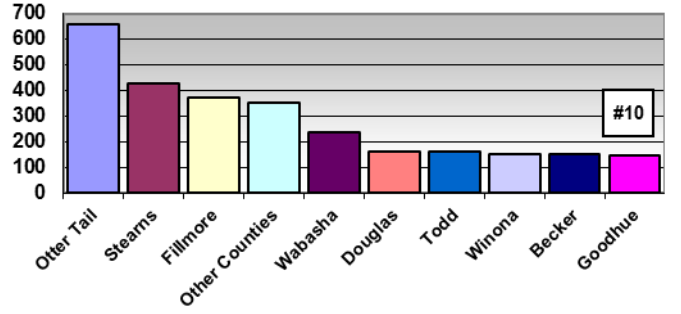
## MN Top Counties: Milk Cows (1,000 head)



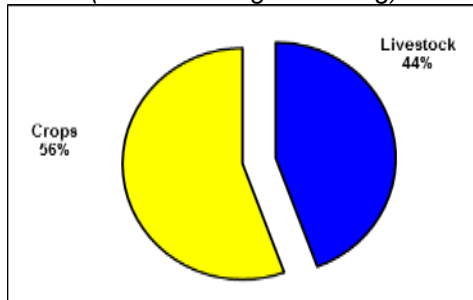
## MN Top 10 Counties: All Cattle (1,000 head)



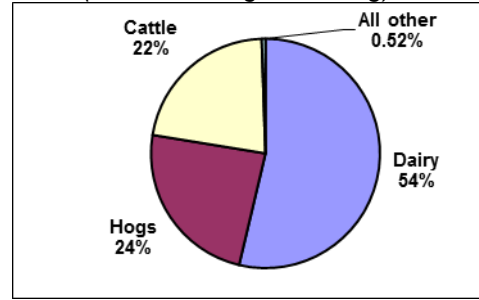
## MN Top Counties: Oats (Thousand bu.)



## Goodhue County Crops & Livestock Production (%-share in Ag Marketing)

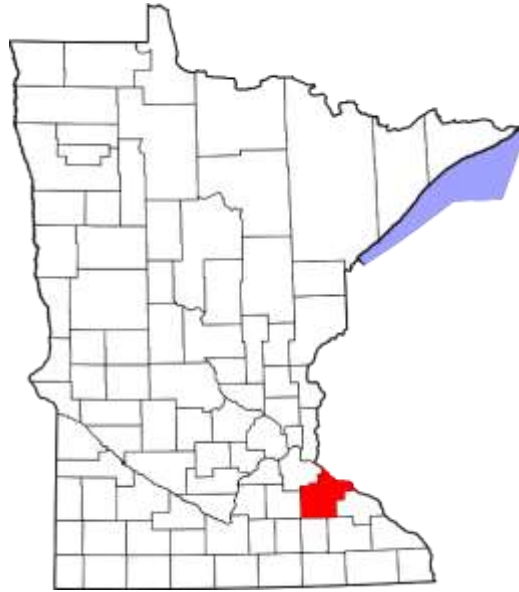


## Goodhue County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
