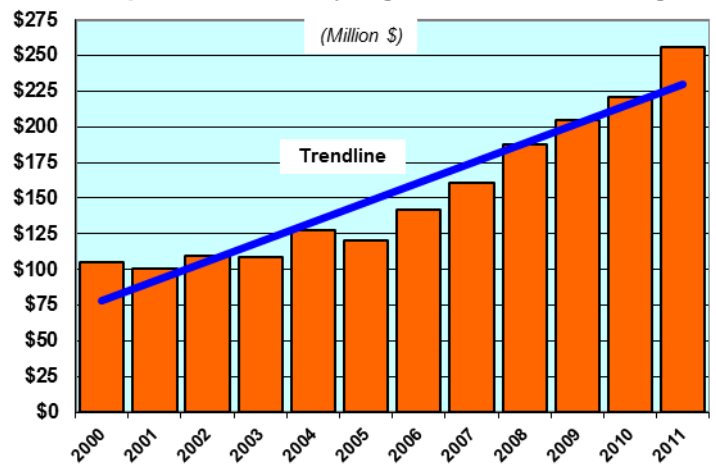

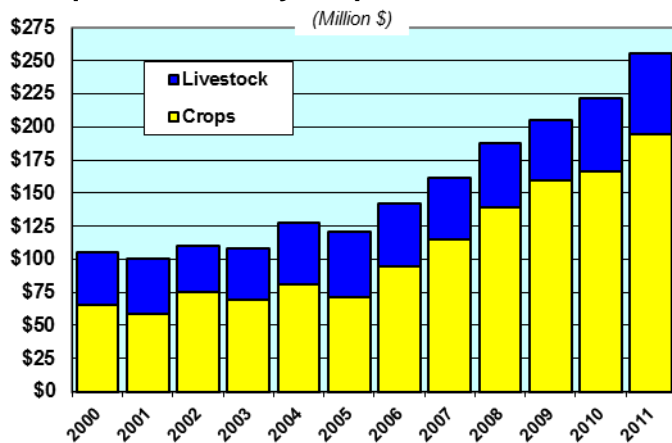

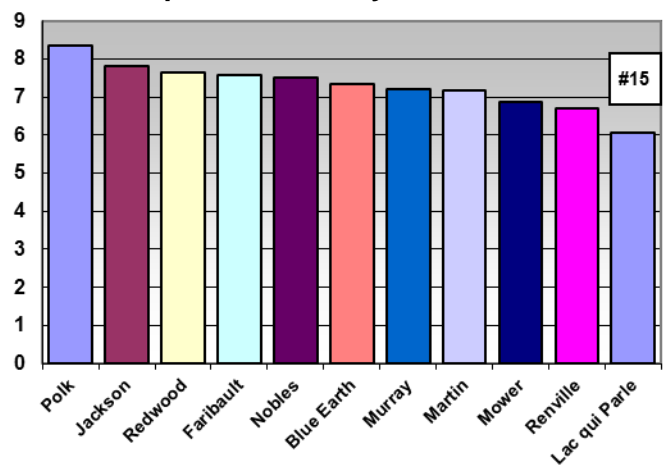

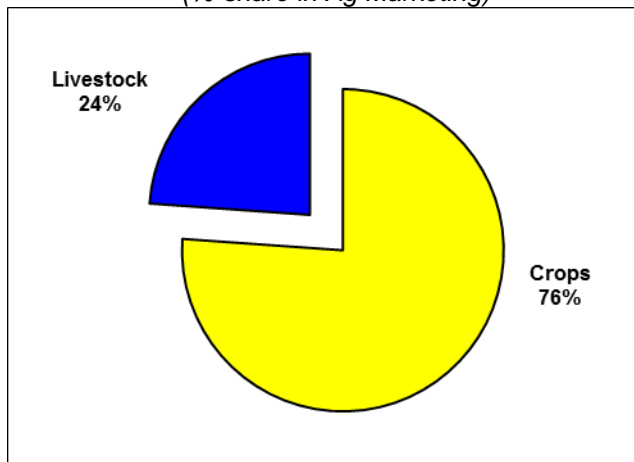
Lac qui Parle County Crop & Livestock Marketing



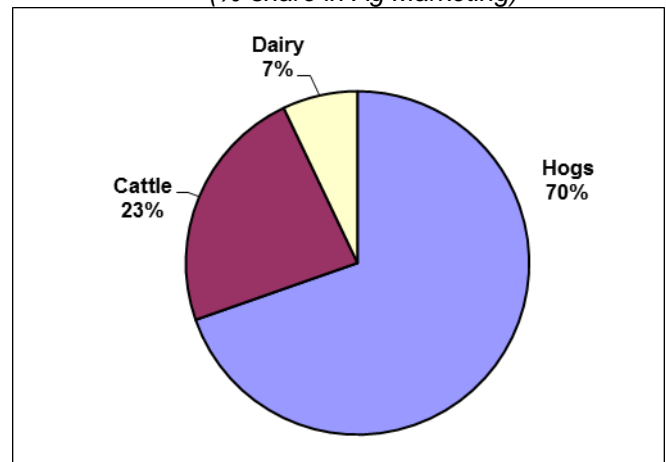
MN Top Counties: Soybeans (Million bu.)



Lac qui Parle County Crop & Livestock (%-share in Ag Marketing)

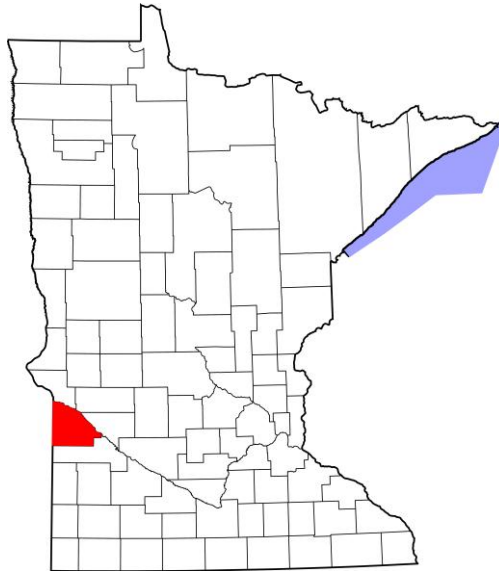


Lac qui Parle County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
