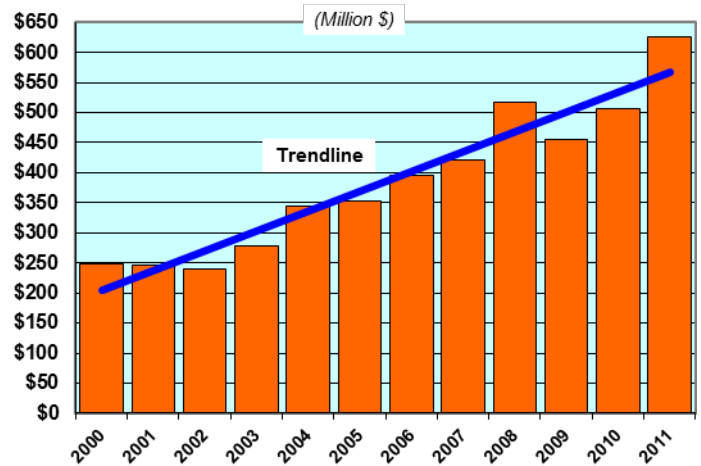

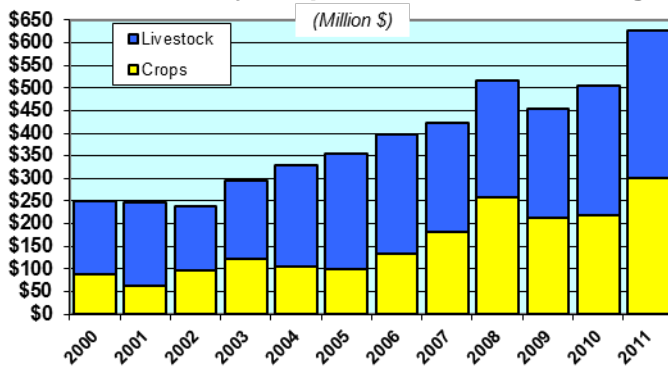

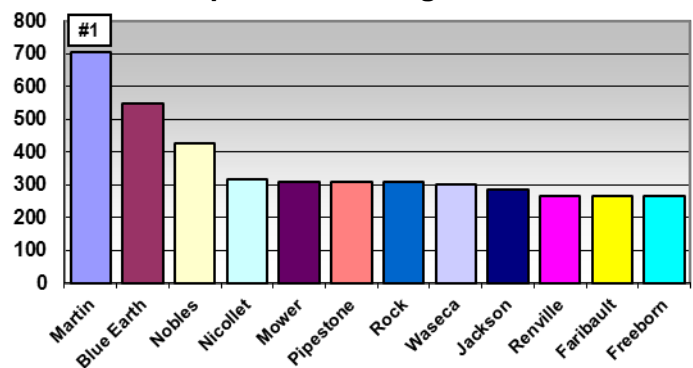

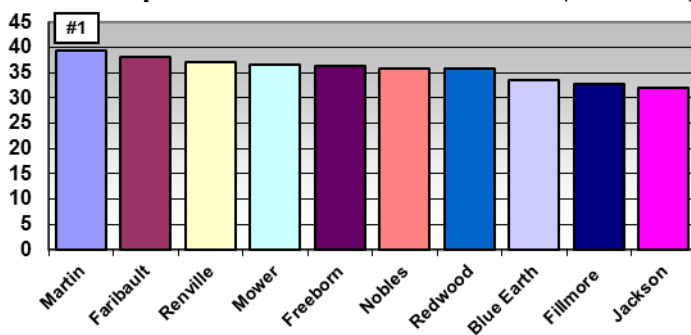

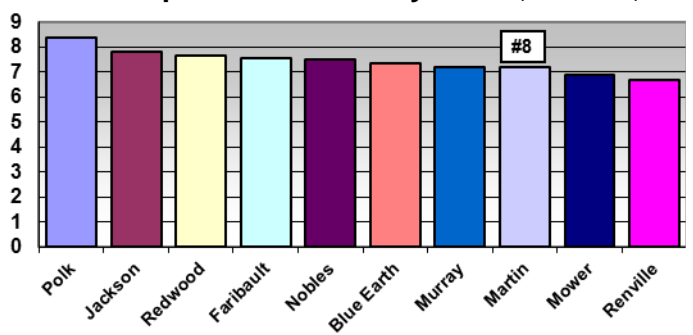
MN Top Counties: Hogs (1,000 head)



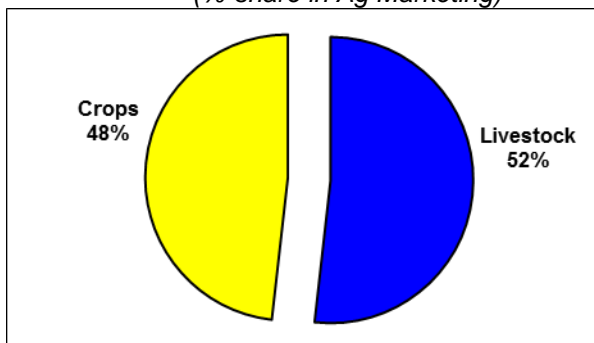
MN Top 10 Counties: Corn for Grain (Million bu.)



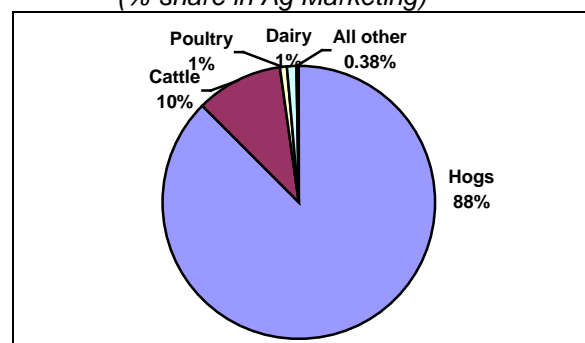
MN Top 10 Counties: Soybeans (Million bu.)



Martin County Crop & Livestock Production (%-share in Ag Marketing)

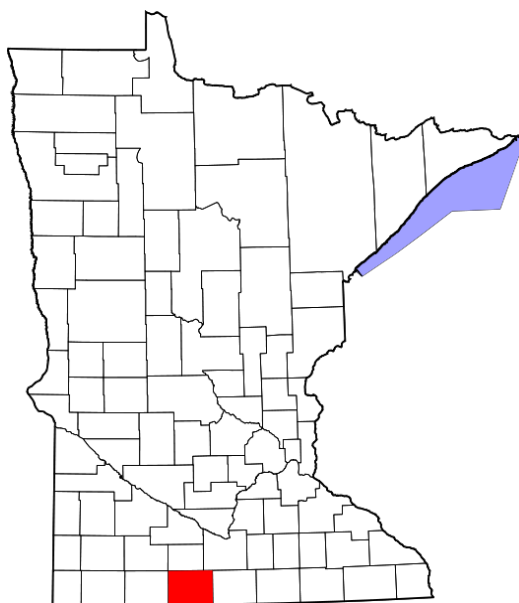


Martin County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
