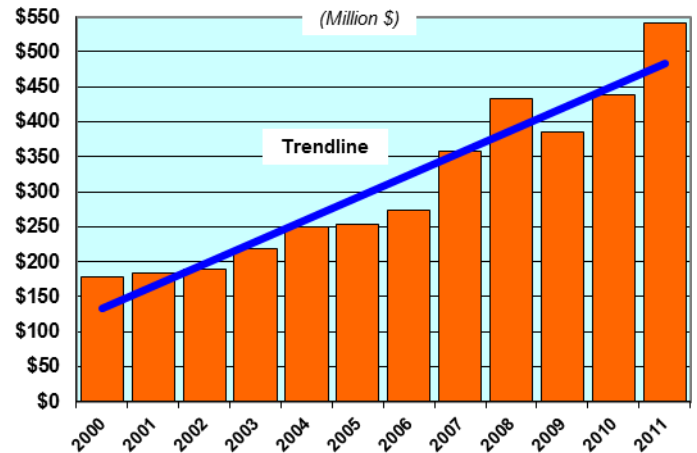

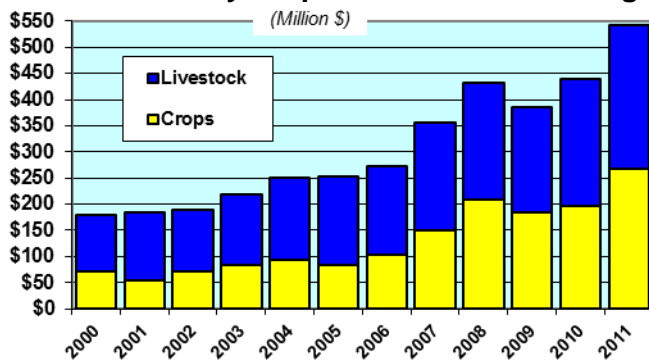

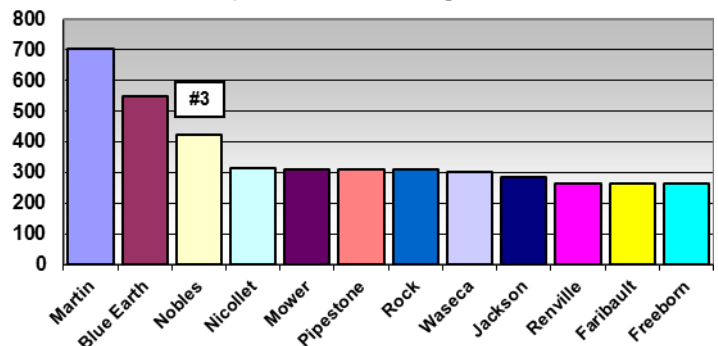

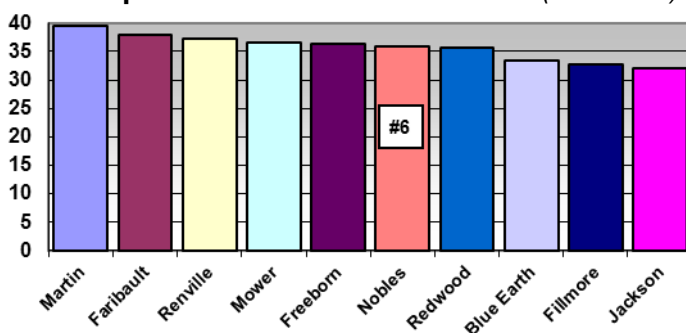

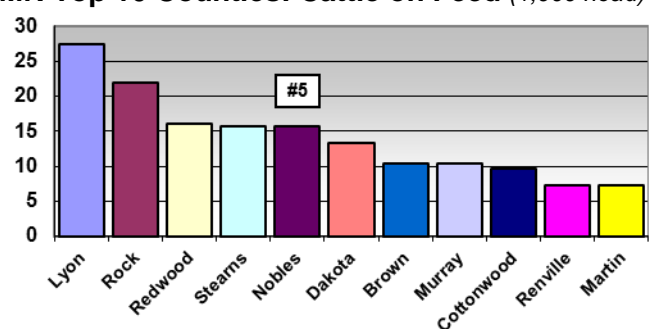
MN Top Counties: Hogs (1,000 head)



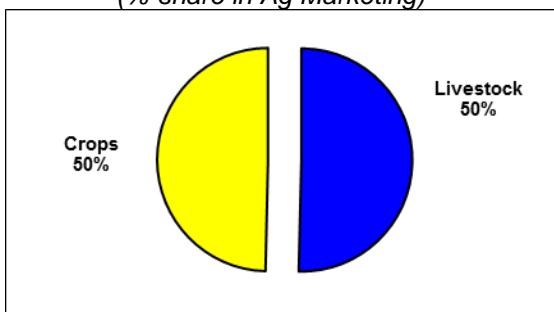
MN Top 10 Counties: Corn for Grain (Million bu.)



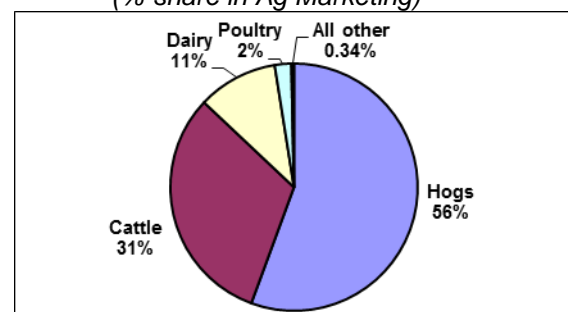
MN Top 10 Counties: Cattle on Feed (1,000 head)



Nobles County Crop & Livestock Production (%-share in Ag Marketing)

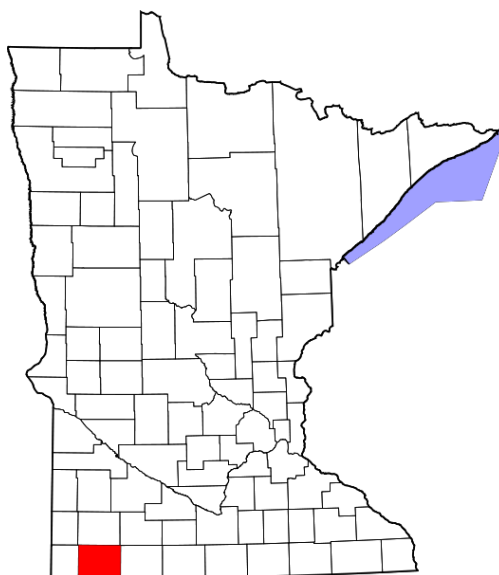


Nobles County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
