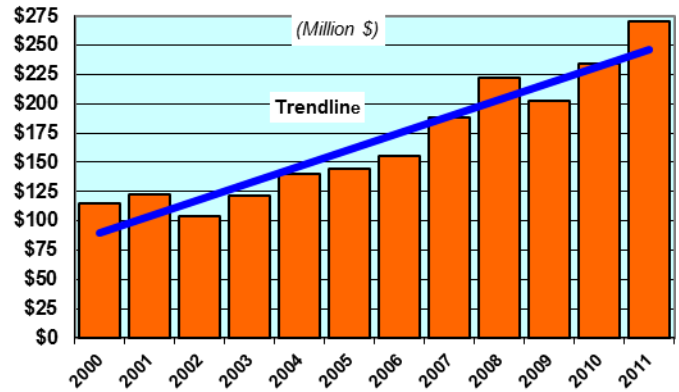

  - Non-farm employment: 5,565 jobs

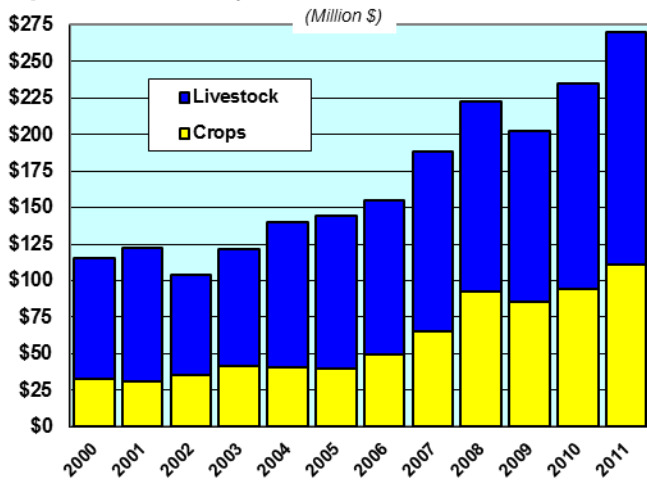

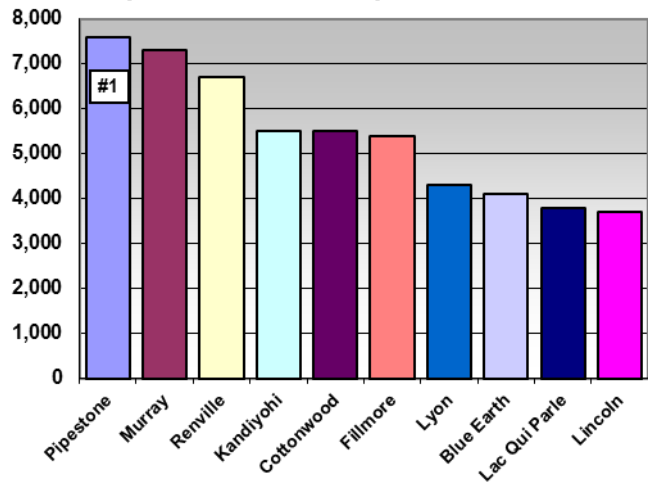

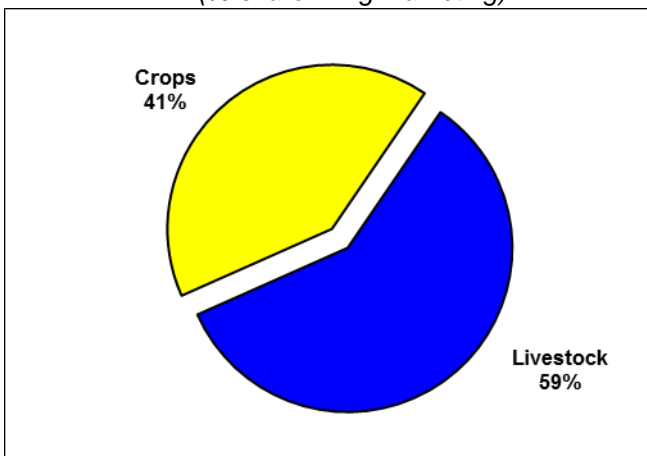
## Pipestone County Crops & Livestock Marketing



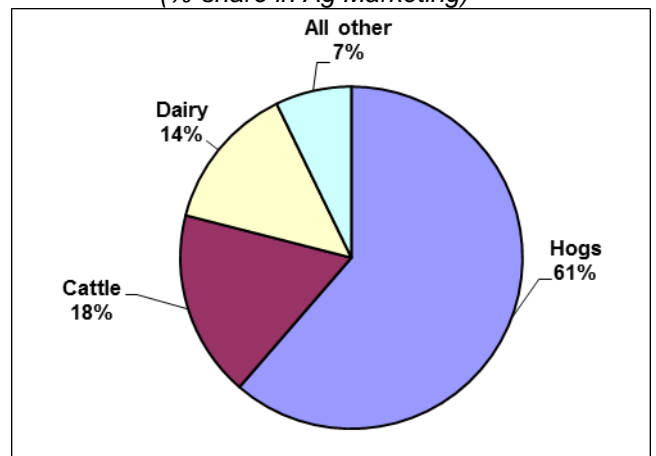
## MN Top Counties: Sheep & Lambs (head)



## Pipestone County Crops & Livestock (%-share in Ag Marketing)

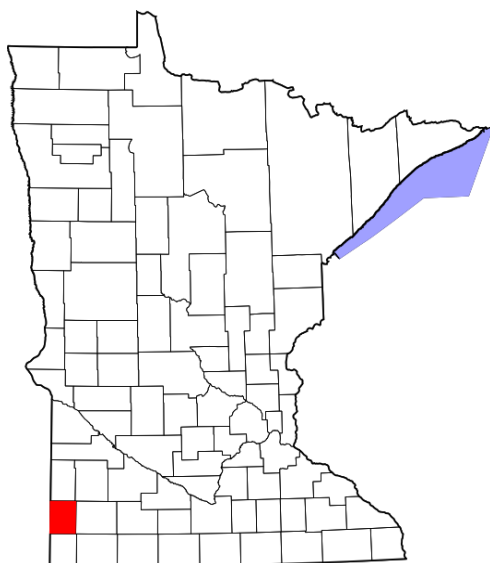


## Pipestone County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
