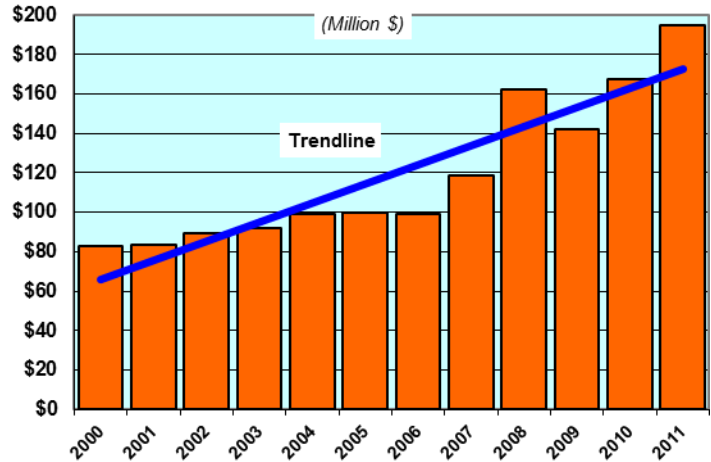

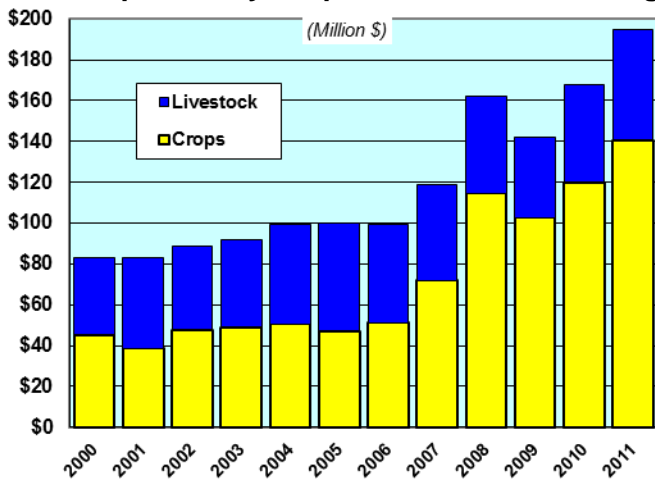

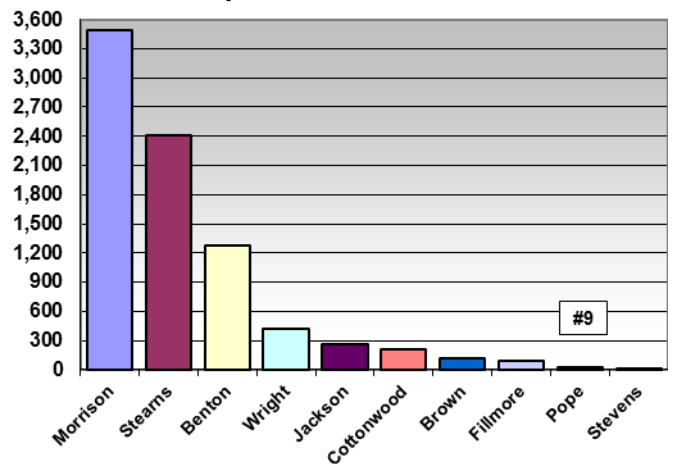

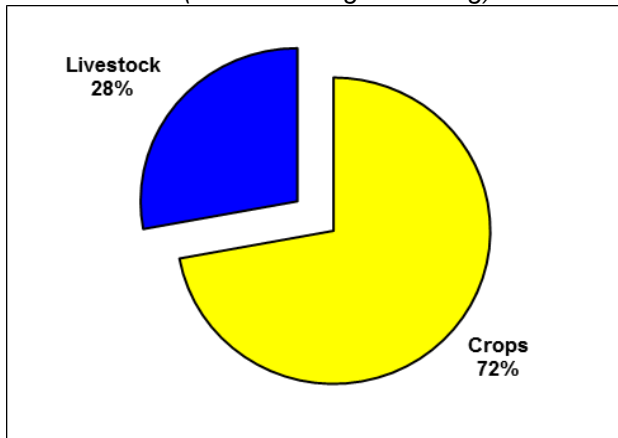
Pope County Crop & Livestock Marketing



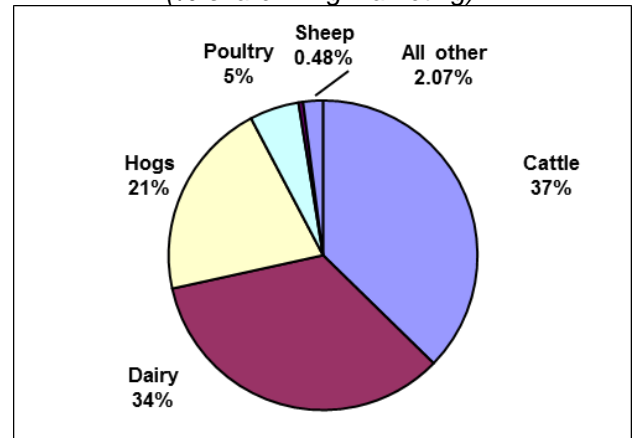
Minnesota Top Counties: Broilers (1,000 head)



Pope County Crop & Livestock (%-share in Ag Marketing)

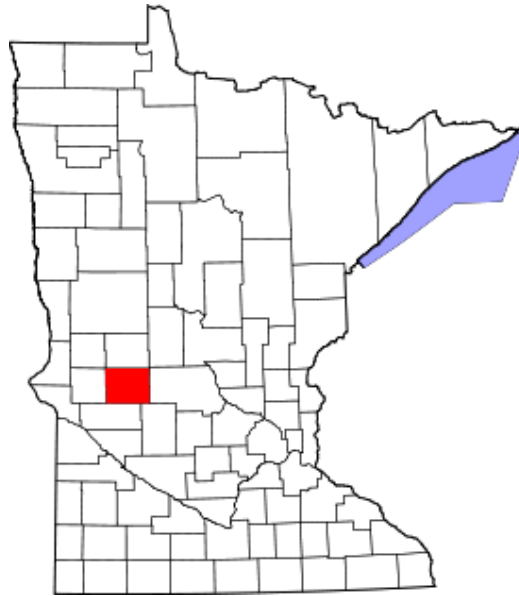


Pope County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
