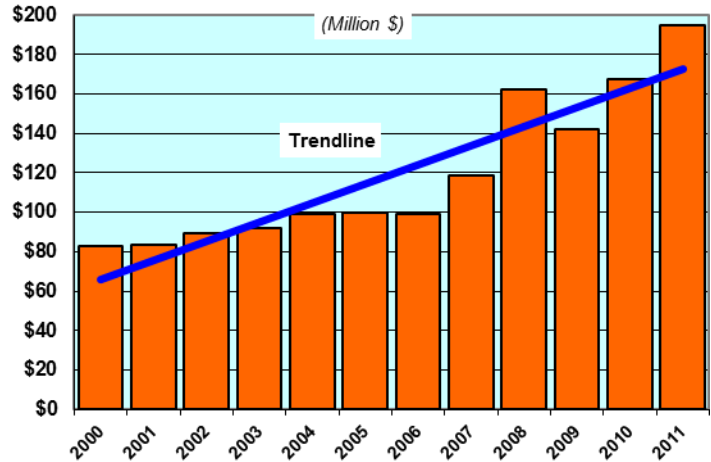

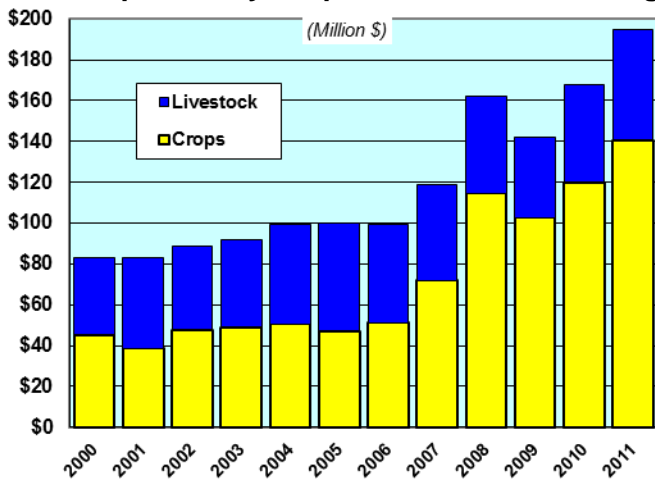

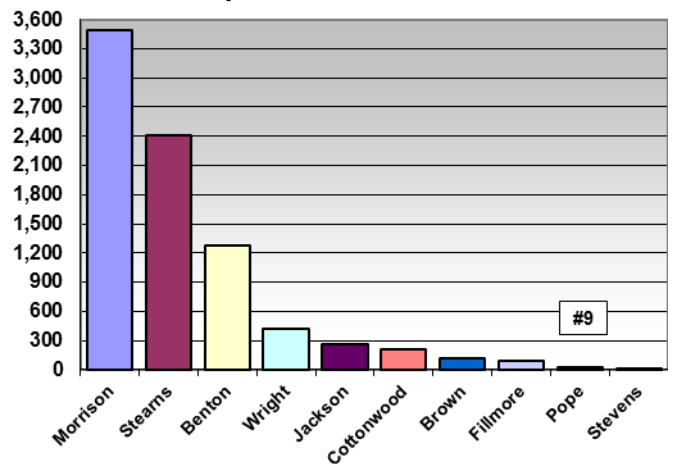

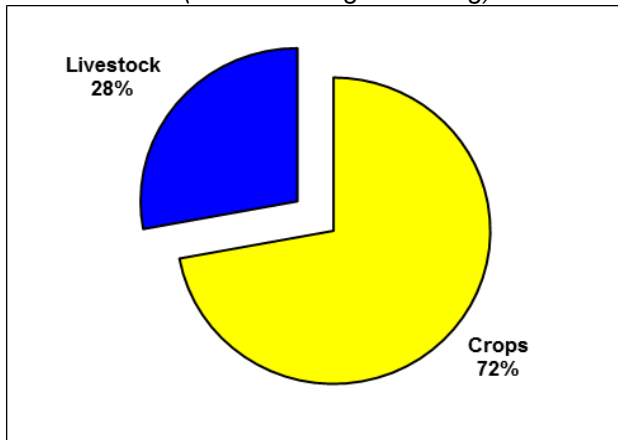
## Pope County Crop & Livestock Marketing



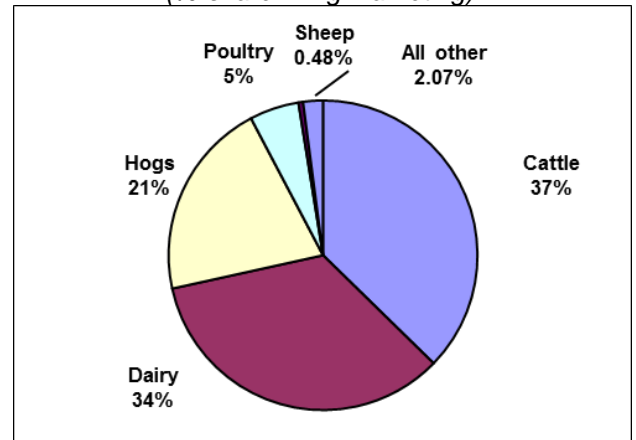
## Minnesota Top Counties: Broilers (1,000 head)



## Pope County Crop & Livestock (%-share in Ag Marketing)

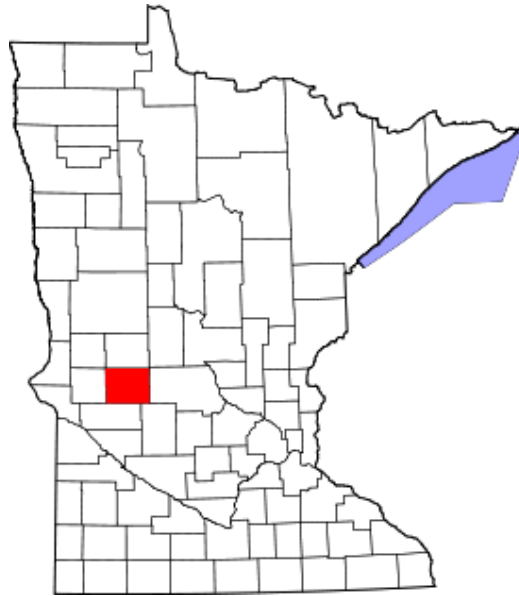


## Pope County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
