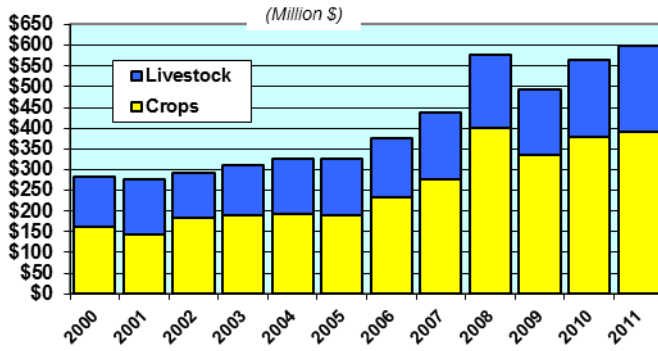

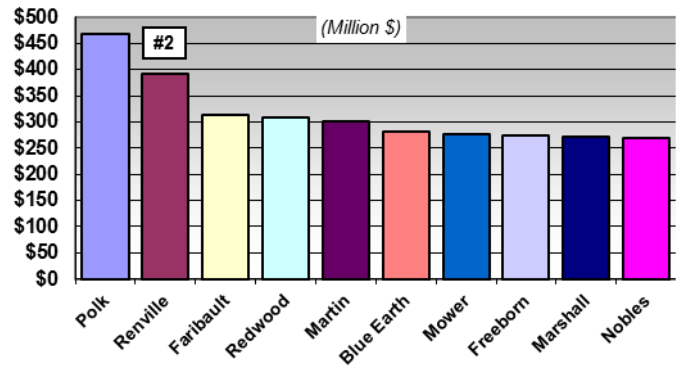

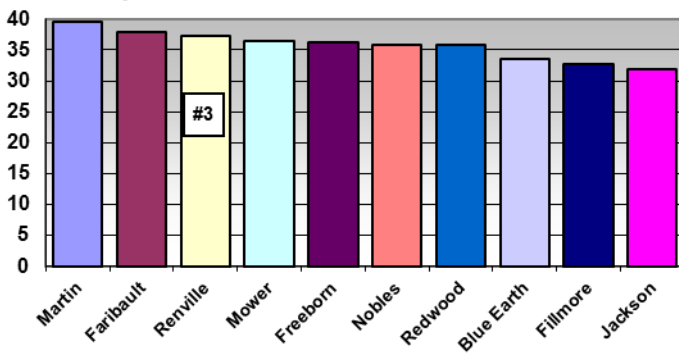
Renville County Crop & Livestock Marketing



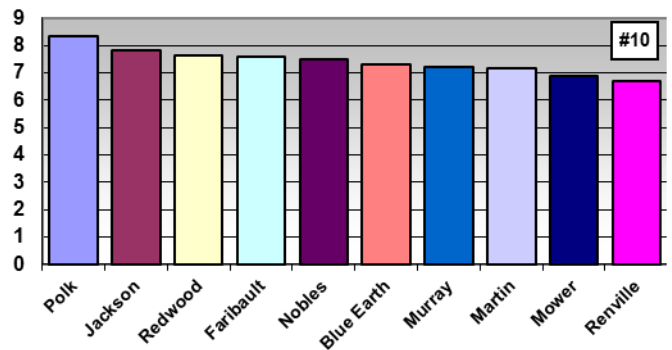
MN Top Counties: Crop Production



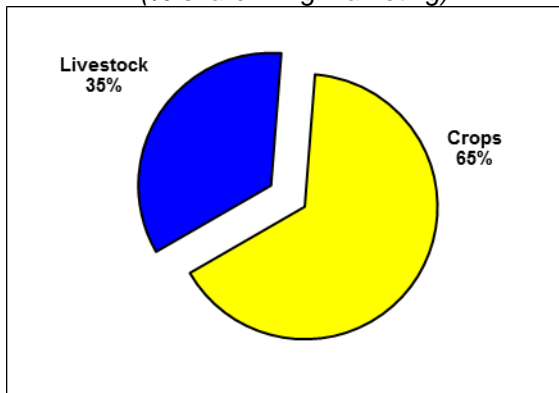
MN Top 10 Counties: Corn for Grain (Million bu.)



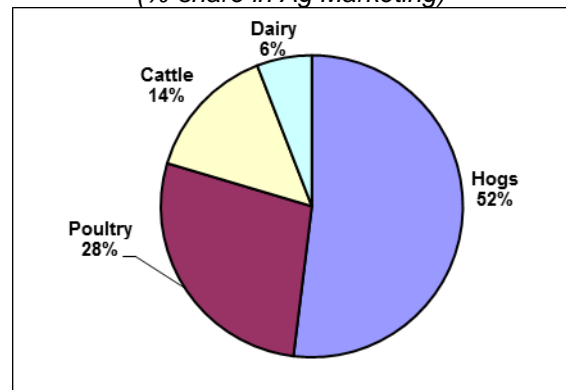
MN Top 10 Counties: Soybeans (Million bu.)

Renville County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)

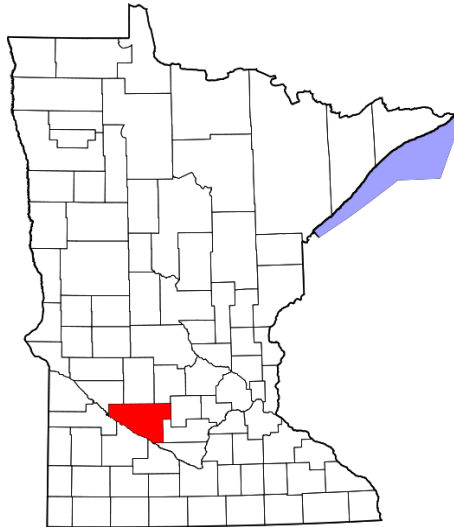
