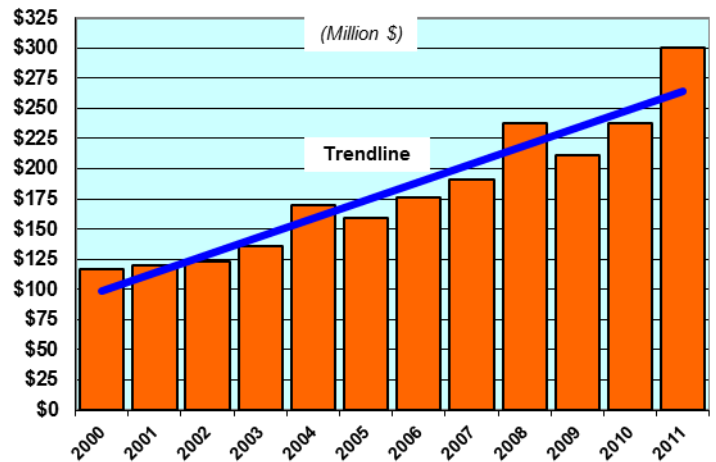

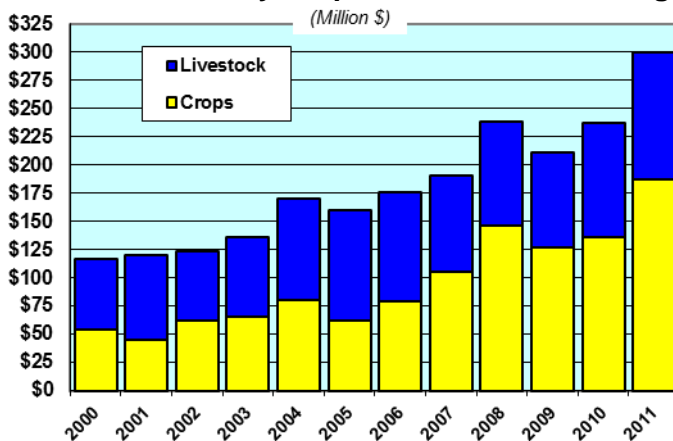

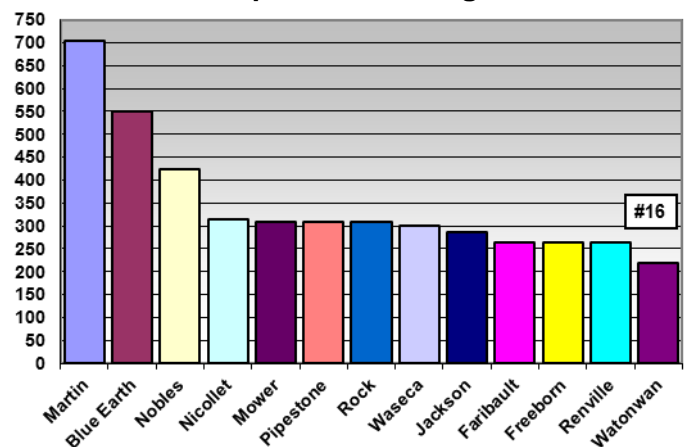

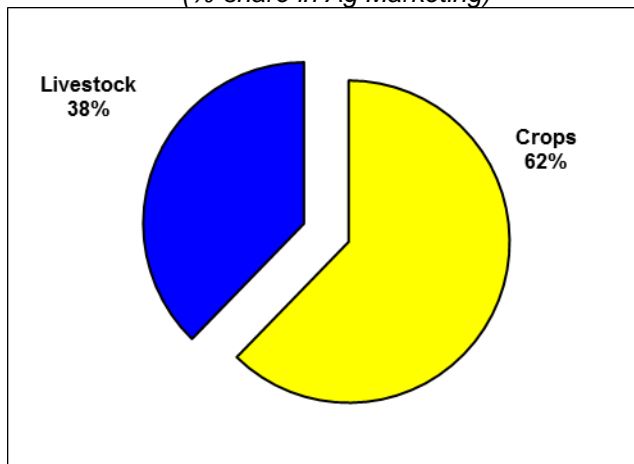
## Watonwan County Crop & Livestock Marketing



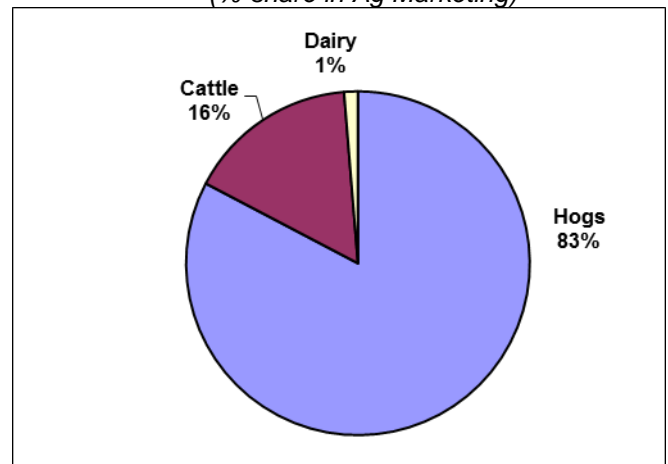
## Minnesota Top Counties: Hogs (1,000 head)



## Watonwan County Crop & Livestock Marketing (%-share in Ag Marketing)

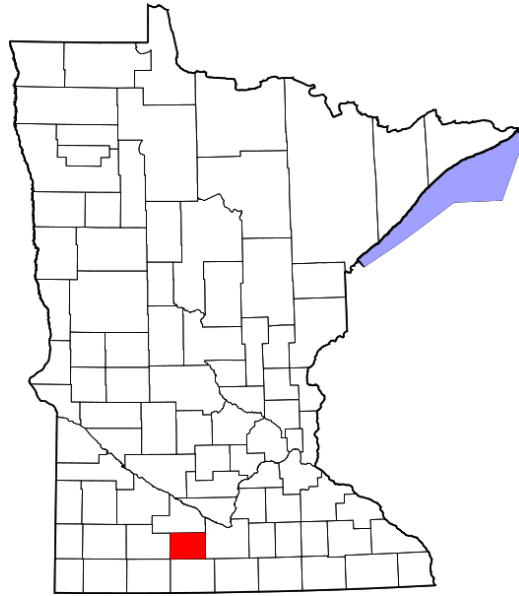


## Watonwan County Livestock Sectors (%-share in Ag Marketing)
