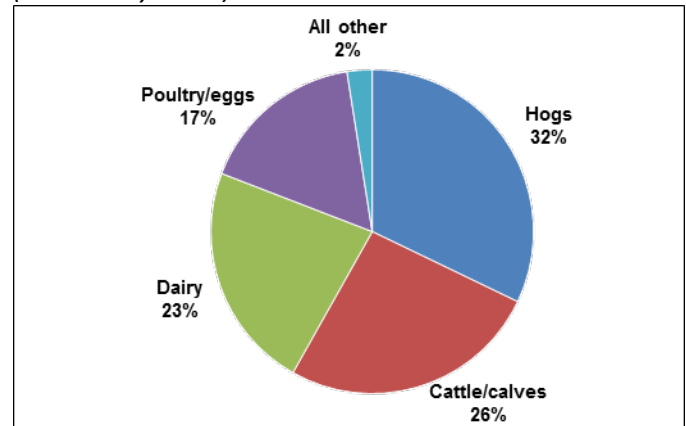

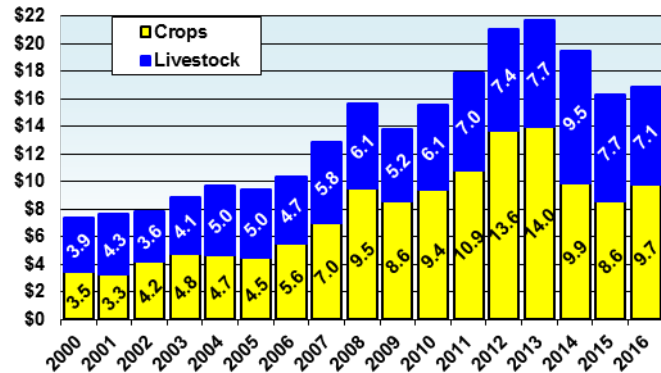
MN Livestock Production

(%-share by value)



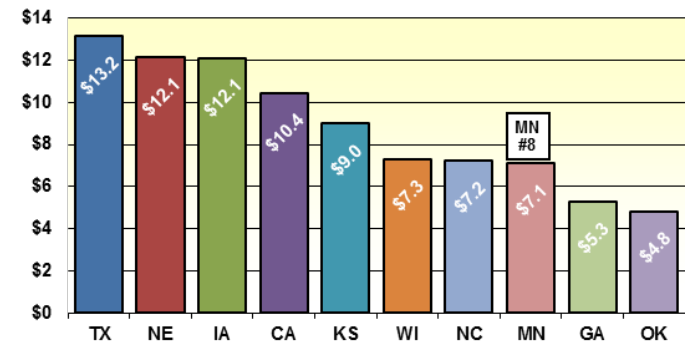
MN Crop & Livestock Production Trends

(Billion \$)



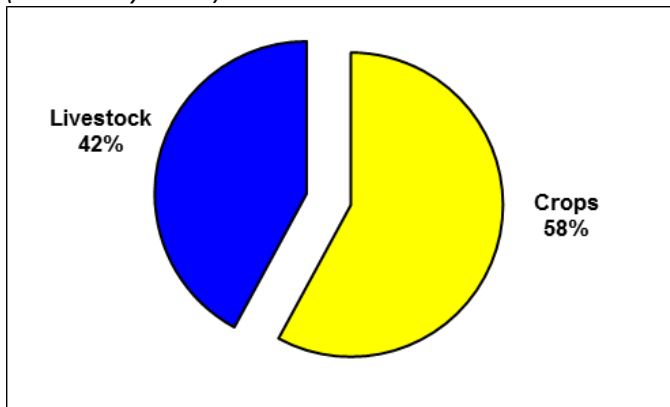
U.S. Livestock Production: Top 10 States

(Billion \$)



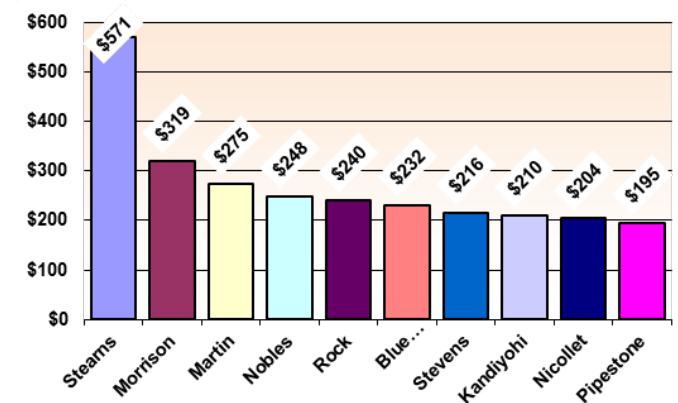
MN Crop & Livestock Production

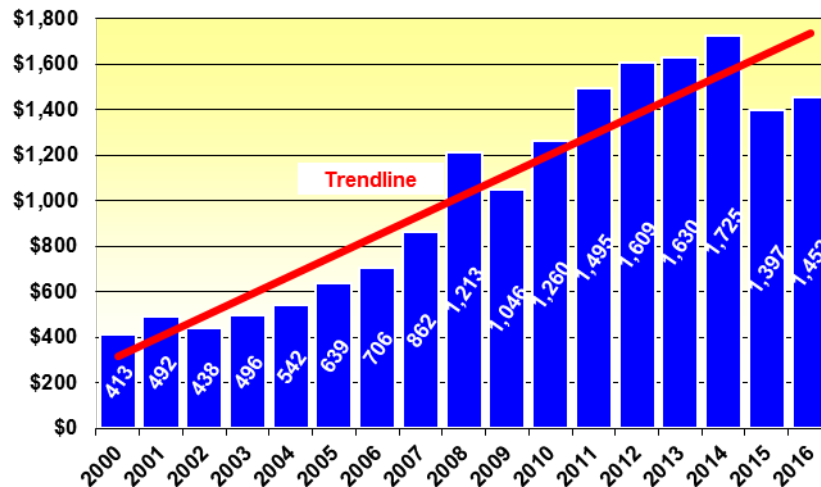

Minnesota Livestock Exports

- Minnesota livestock exports reached \$1.5 billion in 2016 (latest data available).
- Livestock exports account for 20% of Minnesota’s total agricultural exports.
- Pork is Minnesota’s No. 1 livestock export product, with an export value of \$717 million, followed by dairy at \$219 million, beef at \$184 million, and poultry at \$162 million.
- Largest export markets for Minnesota livestock products:
 - Top markets for pork: Japan, Mexico, China, Canada, South Korea
 - Top markets for dairy: Mexico, Canada, China, Japan, South Korea
 - Top market for beef: Japan, South Korea, Mexico, China, Canada
 - Top market for poultry: Mexico; Canada, China, Taiwan, Japan

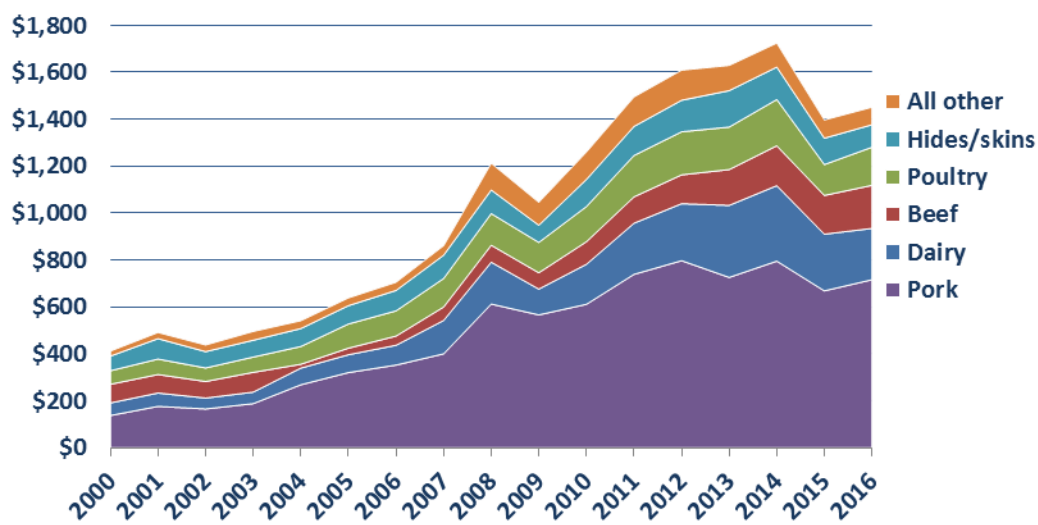
Minnesota Livestock Export Trend
