
MN Agricultural Rankings

 - o #5 in mink pelts



(Billion \$)




U.S. Top 10 States: Crops

(Billion \$)







U.S. Top 10 States: Total Agriculture




U.S. Top 10 States: Livestock



Minnesota Agriculture Facts

- Population: 5.5 million ranks 21st in the U.S. (Rural: 23%; urban: 77%)
- Farm land: 26 million acres (51% of total land area)
- Number of farms: 73,000
- Average farm size: 355 acres
- Agricultural marketing: \$16.8 billion (2016)
 - o Crops: \$9.7 billion
 - Livestock: \$7.1 billion


Minnesota Agricultural Exports


- National ranking: 4th largest agricultural exporting state in the U.S.
- 2016 agricultural exports: \$7.13 billion (nearly onethird of the state's total merchandise exports)




Minnesota Ag Export by Commodity

(%-share by value)






Minnesota Agricultural Export Trends
