Good Agricultural Practices/Good Handling Practices (GAP/GHP) Cost Share Application

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I become GAP/GHP certified?

Third party certification is required to become GAP/GHP certified. For more information or to schedule an audit, please call 651-201-6067 or visit the Minnesota Department of Agriculture's (MDA) Fruit and Vegetable Inspections Webpage: www.mda.state.mn.us/fruit-and-vegetable-inspections

Producers and handlers certified to USDA GAP/GHP standards by an accredited certifier are eligible for this program if:

- Certification was awarded or continuing between 05/16/2018 and 05/15/2019; and
- The address on your certificate is located in Minnesota.

What kind of costs qualify for reimbursement?

GAP/GHP certification costs. Costs associated with becoming eligible for GAP/GHP certification, such as installing hand sinks and drains or hiring a contractor to oversee the plan, are ineligible for reimbursement.

How do I apply?

Mail your application to the MDA by 05/31/2019. Farms must submit proof of certification and copies of invoices issued by their certifier (no self-completed worksheets or cancelled checks).

How much am I eligible for?

Payments depend on the total certification costs incurred between 05/16/2018 and 05/15/2019. In no case will payments exceed 75% of the documented costs (or \$2500) of certification.

When is the application due?

The application and all required supporting documentation must be postmarked no later than 05/31/2019. If postmark is illegible, we will consider the application to have been postmarked one day prior to receipt. Late applications will be denied.

What about my privacy?

Under state law, we must provide demographic information, like your name and address, if asked. We do not release social security numbers or individual payment amounts.

What if I have certified more than once during the eligibility period?

You are eligible for payment with each certification completed during the eligibility time period.
