Video Settings

Whether shooting on a video camera, DSLR, or the Osmo, use the following video settings:

- Frame rate – 24p (or 23.97)
- Shutter speed – 1/48 or 1/50
- Size – 1920x1080
- Aspect ratio – 16:9

Video Export Specifications

When your final cut is finished and approved, following these exporting guidelines:

- YouTube
 - Format: Mp4
 - Codec: H.264, no interlacing
 - Stereo Audio (at 384 kbps) or Stereo + 5.1 (at 512 kbps)
 - Sample Rate: 48 khz or 96 khz
 - Bitrate: 5 Mbps if final resolution is 720p. 8 Mbps if final resolution is 1080p. 1080p is preferred.
 - Aspect Ratio: 16:9
- Facebook
 - Format: Mp4 or MOV
 - Codec: H.264, no interlacing
 - Stereo Audio (at 384 kbps) or Stereo + 5.1 (at 512 kbps)
 - Maximum File Size: 4 GB
- Twitter
 - Format: Mp4 or MOV
 - Codec: H.264
 - AAC Audio
 - Maximum File Size: 512 MB
 - Maximum Video Size: 1280 by 1020 (exporting at 720p should address this issue)
 - Maximum Length: 2 minutes and 20 seconds
- Full HD
 - MOV
 - Codec: H.264, Apple ProRes 422
 - Aspect Ratio: 16:9

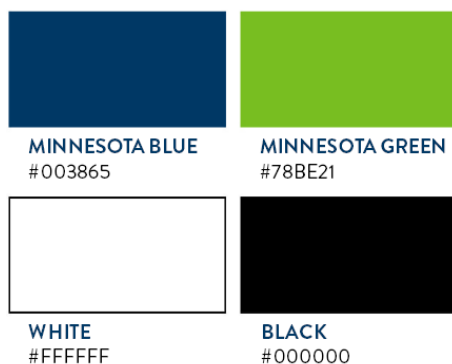
Please also adhere to the following for all MDA videos:
