

Reciprocal Licensee / Applicator's Acknowledgement of Minnesota Pesticide Control Law

Minnesota Statute Section 18B.29 and Minnesota Administrative Rule Part 1505.1290

For the purpose of securing and maintaining a Minnesota Department of Agriculture Pesticide Applicator License, I, do hereby state that I have read the Minnesota Pesticide Control Law, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 18B, and am aware of its provisions, and agree to fully comply with its requirements.

Furthermore, I acknowledge that violation of the above law, or the cancellation of my license or certification in my home state, may be considered by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture as grounds for cancellation of my license and certification, enforcement action, including possible imposition of monetary penalties, or both.

Reciprocal License Requirements - Acknowledgement of Minnesota Pesticide Law and Regulations

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA) received your request for a Reciprocal License to apply pesticides in Minnesota based on existing licensure and residency in your home state. As the administrator of state pesticide laws and regulations, the MDA notifies persons applying for a Minnesota Pesticide Applicator License of regulatory responsibilities and requirements.

As part of the Reciprocal License certification process, you will need to provide the following:

- 1) A legible copy of the front and back of your resident state pesticide certification or license showing the categories and expiration date.

- 2) A legible copy of your driver's license or other document that identifies your legal state of residence.
- 3) A signed "Reciprocal Licensee/Applicator's Acknowledgement of Minnesota Pesticide Law" stating that you have read and are aware of the provisions of the Minnesota Pesticide Control Law, will fully comply with all applicable regulatory responsibilities, and are aware of the consequences of violating the Minnesota Pesticide Control Law. **This MUST be signed by the applicator.**

Please note that Minnesota reciprocity is based on residency. Therefore, your pesticide certification/license AND your driver's license MUST be from the SAME state. For more information on Reciprocity, please visit www.mda.state.mn.us/licensing/licensetypes/pesticideapplicator/reciprocal1

You may not apply pesticides for hire in Minnesota until you receive a valid Minnesota pesticide applicator license ID card.
