

Stewardship Guidelines and Best Management Practices (BMPs)FOR PESTICIDE TREATED SEED 2025

When Preparing for the Growing Season

- Adopt an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) approach
- Don't rely solely on seed treatments
- If pest risk is low, consider seeds not treated with pesticides

When Planting Treated Seed

READ DIRECTIONS

PREPARE FOR PLANTING

EXERCISE CAUTION WHEN PLANTING



Follow requirements for proper handling, storage, use and disposal of treated seed and understand hazard statements related to pollinators and water quality

Assess planting equipment, ensure proper calibration and planter maintenance, and select appropriate lubricants to reduce dust

Plant during appropriate weather conditions, prevent spillage, and minimize postplanting dust

Always Keep in Mind

POLLINATOR HEALTH

- Familiarize yourself with pollinator-friendly habitat near your farm and prevent planting dust from drifting to those habitats
- Follow MDA BMPs to promote pollinator habitat in agricultural landscapes

WATER QUALITY

- Avoid planting treated seed during wind to minimize dust movement toward water
- Do not bury excess treated seed or clean planting equipment near water

DISPOSAL

 Follow MPCA requirements when disposing of excess treated seed
