- Use a curbside tree collection or bring to a designated drop-off site. Check with your waste hauler, city, or county to see what services are offered in your area.
- Dispose of wreaths and other decorative greens in your trash cans.
- Do not toss trees and greenery into backyard woods or your residential compost pile.
- The last resort would be to burn the greens. Always check with local ordinances first and follow them.
