Seed Inspection Request ENTRY AND INSPECTION BY AUTHORITY OF M. S. 18J.04

The Minnesota Government Data Practices Act classifies the identity of persons who register complaints with a government agency regarding a licensee or applicant as **private data on individuals** (Minn. Stat. § 13.41, subd. 2(a)). The identity of persons who register complaints regarding violations of state law pertaining to the use of real property is classified as confidential (Minn. Stat. § 13.44). A complainant's identity may be legally disclosed to those agencies and staff authorized to have access in order to investigate or litigate the complaint. If a complaint concerns a licensee or applicant, any other disclosure of the complainant's identity requires written permission (informed consent) or a valid court order. **Please Note:** Write or print clearly using black ink.
