


# MINNESOTA AGRICULTURAL PROFILE


## MN Agricultural Rankings (Among all U.S. states):

- No. 4 in crop cash receipts
  - No. 1 in sugarbeets, sweet corn for processing
  - No. 2 in wild rice, dry edible beans
  - No. 3 in oats, soybeans, spring wheat, sunflower
  - No. 4 in corn, canola
  - No. 7 in barley
- No. 7 in total agricultural cash receipts (\$22.2 billion)
- No. 8 in livestock cash receipts
  - No. 1 in turkeys
  - No. 2 in hogs
  - No. 5 in mink pelts, honey
  - No. 6 cheese
  - No. 7 in milk cows, red meat


## Minnesota Agricultural Marketing (2024)




## Minnesota Crop & Livestock Marketing




## U.S. Top 10 States: Total Agriculture (Billion \$)




## U.S. Top 10 States: Crops (Billion \$)




## U.S. Top 10 States: Livestock (Billion \$)

## Minnesota Livestock Sectors (%-share by value)




# MINNESOTA AGRICULTURAL PROFILE

## Minnesota Agriculture Facts

- Population: 5.7 million – ranks 22nd in the U.S.  
(Rural: 27%; urban: 73%)
- Farm land: 27 million acres  
(53% of total land area)
- Number of farms: 65,300
- Average farm size: 389 acres
- Agricultural marketing: \$25.45 billion (2023)
  - Crops: \$16.1 billion
  - Livestock: \$9.39 billion

## Minnesota Agricultural Exports


- National ranking: 4th largest agricultural exporting state in the U.S.
- 2023 agricultural exports: \$9.15 billion




## U.S. Top 10 Ag Exporting States (Billion \$)
