Our goal is not to take a huge amount of biomass from your field or greenhouse grows. We understand that this is removing part of your valuable crop. However, federal law requires us to sample 5-9 inches of flowers based on an approved sampling plan based on size of the lot. USDA has approved our plan for taking the minimum (5 inches) and we chose the minimum for this very reason. Prior to federal law, MN only took 2inches of the flower, but since the feds have taken over, we have to follow their process.
