The survey showed the following series of images and participants were asked to identify whether they were knotweeds.

By having survey participants identify images of knotweed we can try to determine which characteristics of knotweed are most recognizable and which plants with similar traits may be confused for knotweed. Based on the responses knotweed stems are a trait that many people rely on for knotweed identification.

Each species below has been labeled and responses from the survey are displayed in the right-hand column – correct answers to "Is this a knotweed?" are bolded.
