
## VISITOR AND EMPLOYEE Health Screening Checklist

## Conduct Health Screening Each Time Employees or Visitors Enter The Facility

Have you had any of the following symptoms since your last day at work, or the last time you were here, that you cannot attribute to another health condition?

Please answer "Yes" or "No" to each question. Do you have:

- □ Fever or feeling feverish?
- □ Chills?
- $\Box$  A new cough?
- □ Shortness of breath?
- □ A new sore throat?
- New muscle aches?
- □ New loss of smell or taste?



If a worker or visitor answers "Yes" to any of the screening questions or has a measured temperature above 100.0°F, they should be advised to go home, stay away from other people, and contact their health care provider.

You may also opt to conduct temperature screening, though this is not required and should only be done with proper social distancing, protection, and hygiene protocols. Temperature screening alone is not effective and should not replace the screening questions.
