

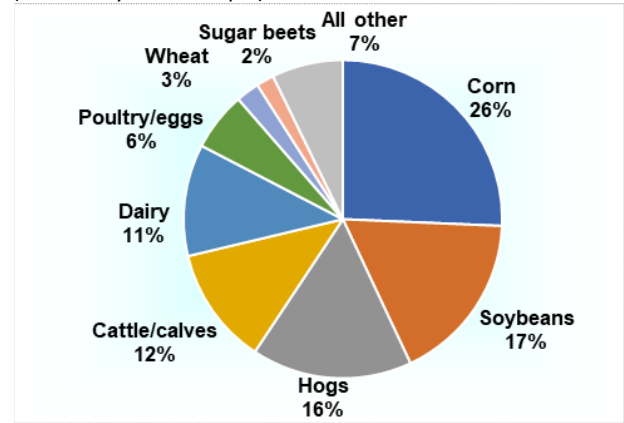

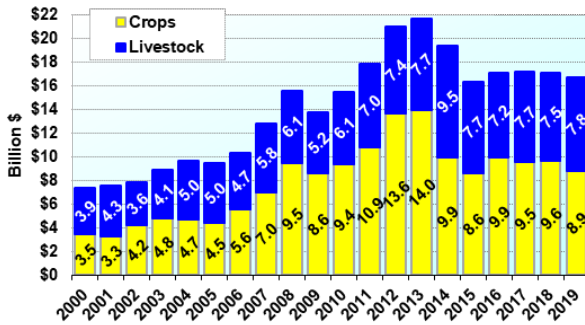
Minnesota Agricultural Marketing

(%-share by cash receipts)



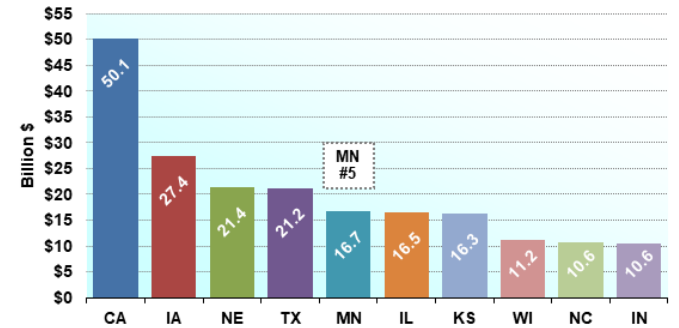
Minnesota Crop & Livestock Marketing

(Billion \$)



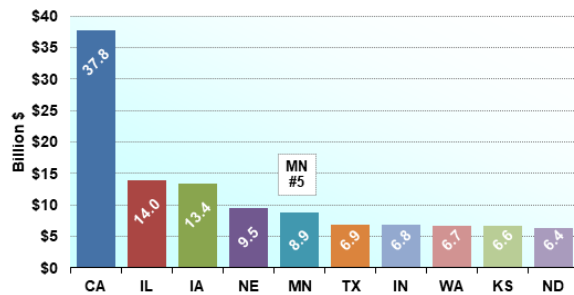
U.S. Top 10 States: Total Agriculture

(Billion \$)



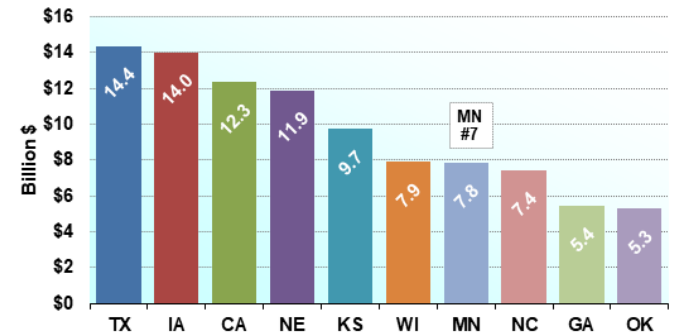
U.S. Top 10 States: Crops

(Billion \$)



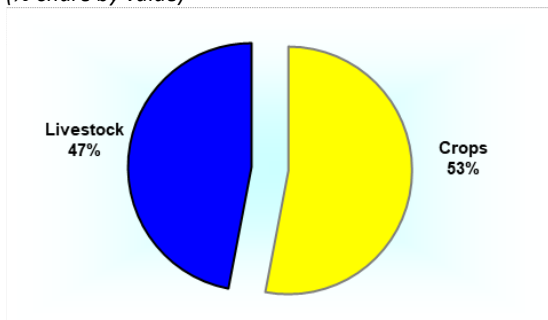
U.S. Top 10 States: Livestock

(Billion \$)



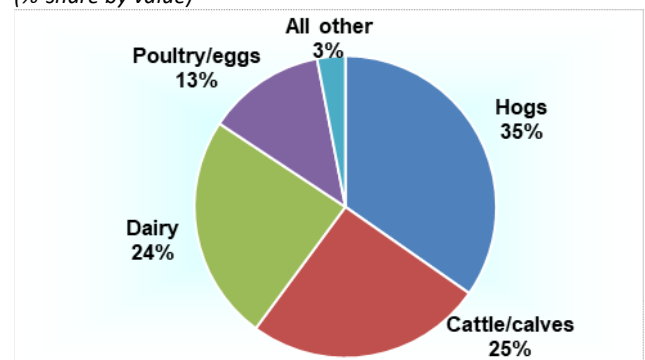
Minnesota Crop & Livestock Production

(%-share by value)



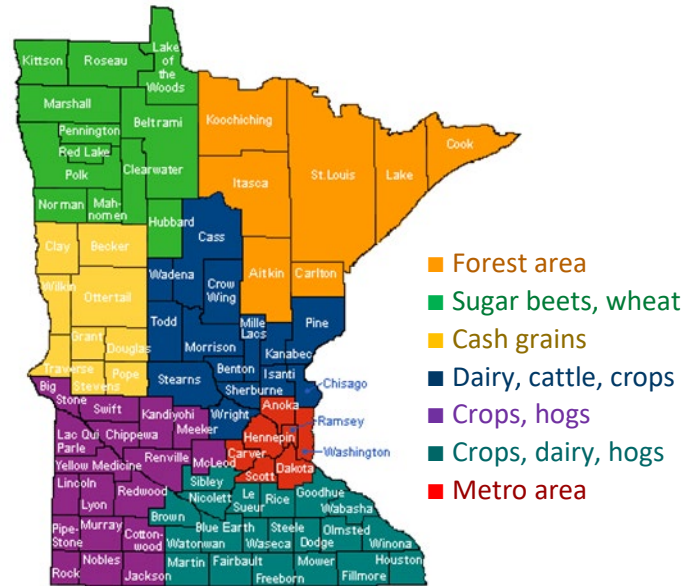

Minnesota Agriculture Facts

- Population: 5.7 million – ranks 22nd in the U.S. (Rural: 23%; urban: 77%)
- Farm land: 26 million acres (51% of total land area)
- Number of farms: 68,000
- Average farm size: 375 acres
- Agricultural marketing: \$16.7 billion (2019)
 - Crops: \$8.85 billion
 - Livestock: \$7.85 billion

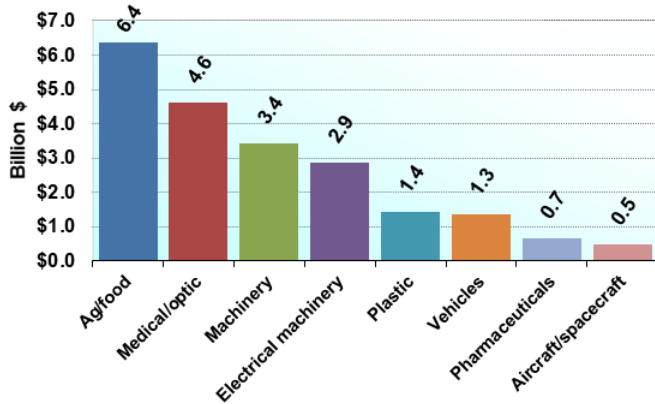
Minnesota Agricultural Exports

- 2019 agricultural exports: \$6.4 billion (accounts for nearly one-third of the state’s total merchandise exports)



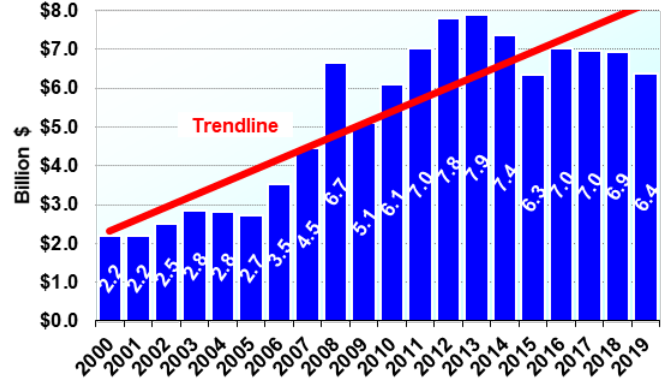
MN Ag Exports: #1 in State’s All Industries

(Billion \$)



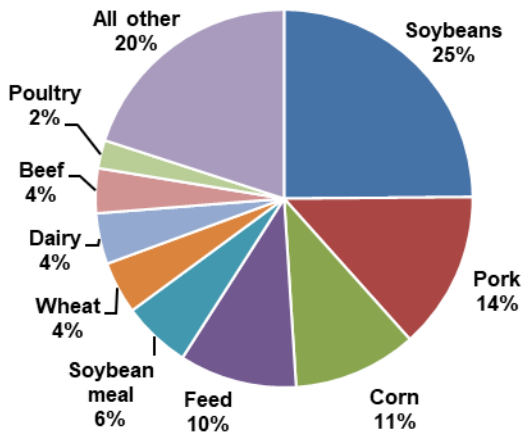
Minnesota Agricultural Export Trends

(Billion \$)



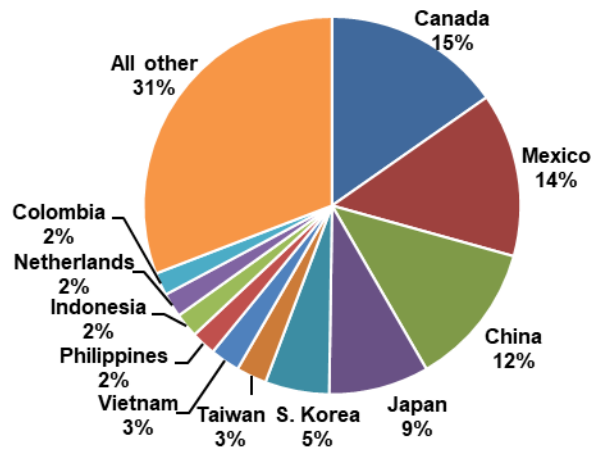
Minnesota Ag Export by Commodity
