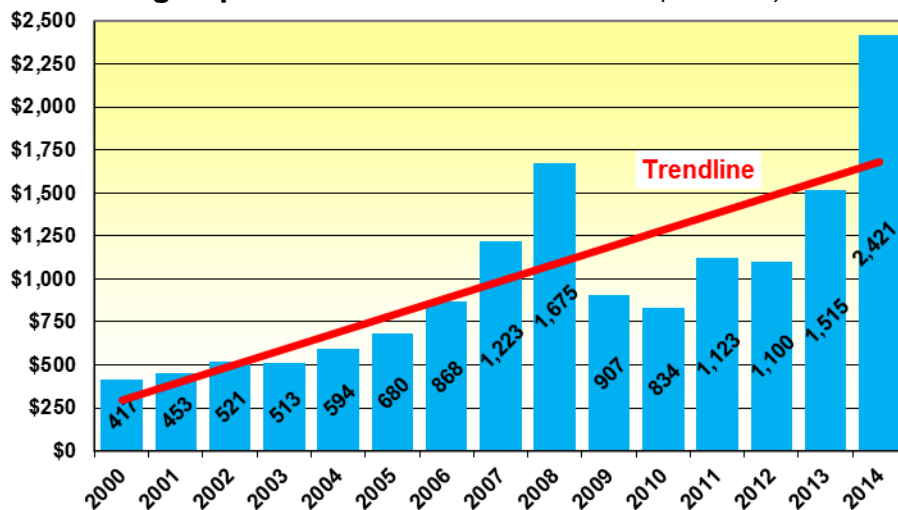


## U.S. AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS TO COLOMBIA

- Colombia is the 8<sup>th</sup> largest export market for U.S. agricultural products, up from 24<sup>th</sup> in 2010.
- In 2014, U.S. agricultural exports to Colombia reached a record high of \$2.4 billion, up from \$1.5 billion in 2013, a 60-percent increase.
- Corn, soybeans and products, wheat, pork, and processed food are among the top export commodities from the U.S. to Colombia, and account for more than 70% of the total.

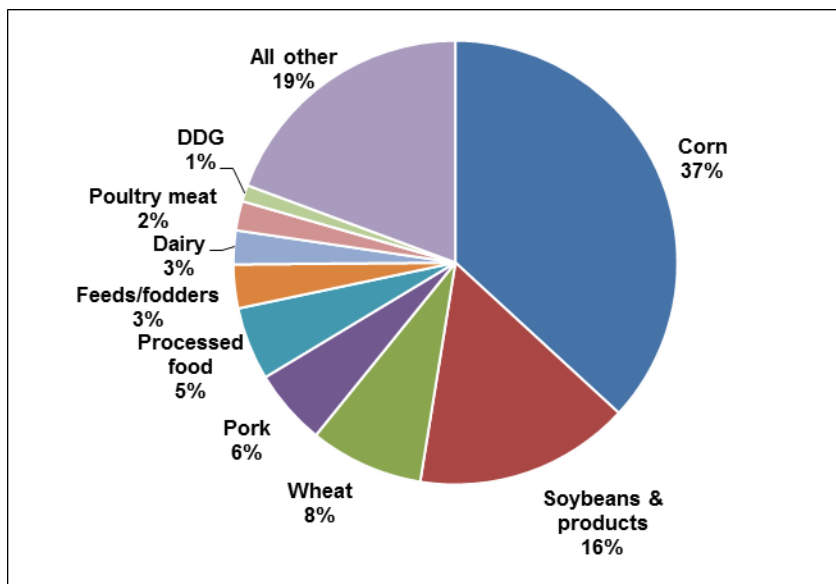


**U.S. Ag Export to Colombia: 2000-2014** (\$ Million)



**U.S. Ag Export to Colombia by Commodity (2014)**

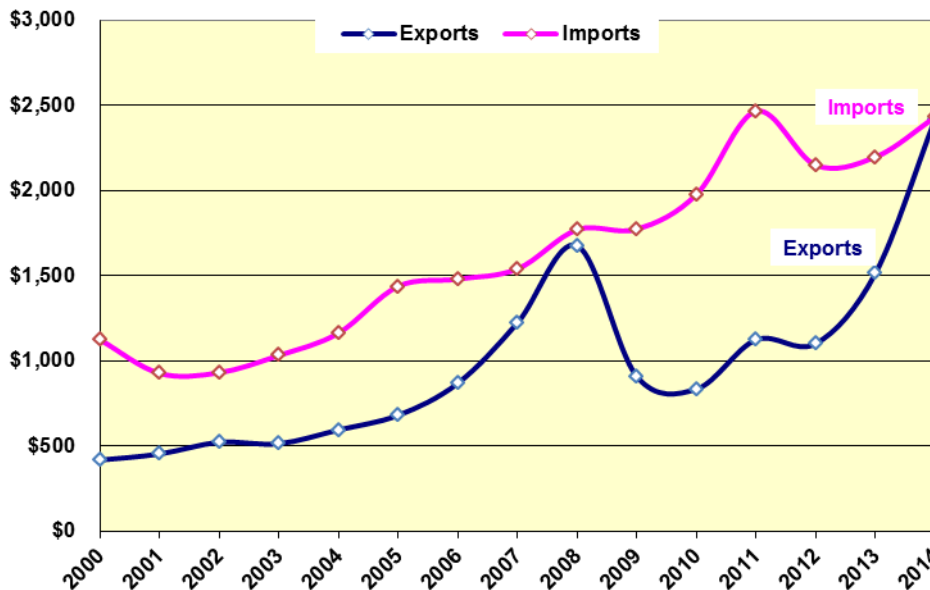

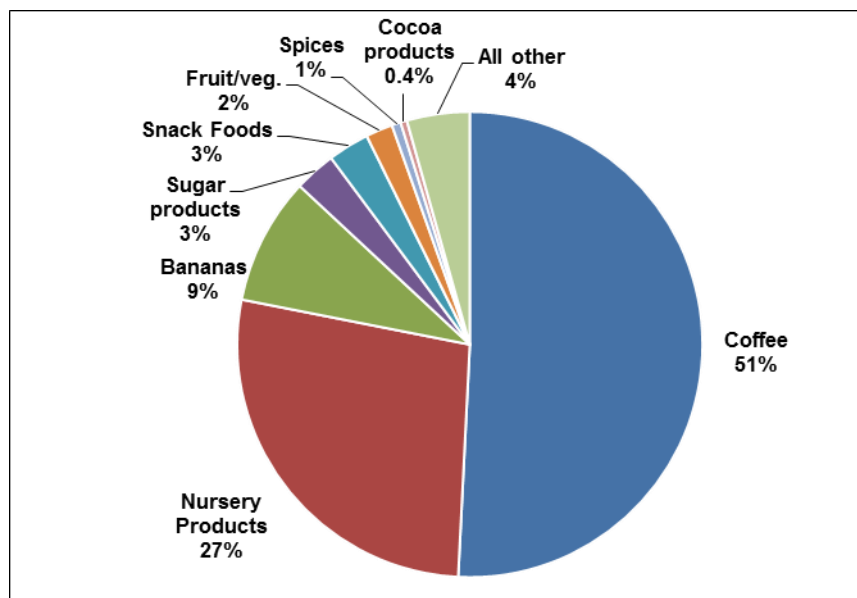
## U.S. AGRICULTURAL IMPORTS FROM COLOMBIA

- The U.S. imported \$2.4 billion in agricultural products from Colombia in 2014, an 11% increase from 2013.
- The top three U.S. import commodities from Colombia are coffee, nursery products, and bananas/plantains, accounting for 88% of the total U.S. ag imports from Colombia.
